


Advanced Placement Guidelines



Subject:	AP
Course Description:	Advanced Placement® is college-level coursework and exams that students can take in high school to receive college credit based on their scores. All motivated and academically-prepared high school students are able to enroll in AP® courses as long as the student has taken the recommended prerequisite courses.
Credit:	0.5 Credit per semester Students have the ability to earn college credit based on his/her AP exam score.
Grading:	<p>Honors Courses Honor Course letter grades have the following GPA weights: A: 4.5 B: 3.5 C: 2.5 D: 1.5</p> <p>Advanced Placement® Courses Grades are weighted for each semester of Advanced Placement® (AP®) courses successfully completed with a grade of “C” or better as follows: A: 5.0 B: 4.0 C: 3.0 Grades below a “C” are not weighted.</p>
Grades:	AP - 9th - 12th Grade Honors - 8th - 10th Grade (recommended)

Requirements:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Attendance & participation is required 2. Course materials 3. AP Contract
AP Exams & Fee:	<p>It is highly recommended that students sit for the AP® examinations in May. While exams are not mandatory at Epic, they will provide students the opportunity to gain college credit.</p> <p>Students may use their LF to pay for exams if fees are available.</p> <p>Exams are \$99 per exam. The late order fee/cancellation fee is \$40.</p>
Enrollment:	<p>Course request for Enrollment is available on the ILP. Deadline to enroll is September 15th, 2024 or until seats are full.</p> <p>Seats are limited/first come, first serve.</p> <p>The deadline to drop an AP® course is 14 days after initial enrollment. After 14 days, students cannot be changed from the course under any circumstances, even if they are failing the class.</p>
