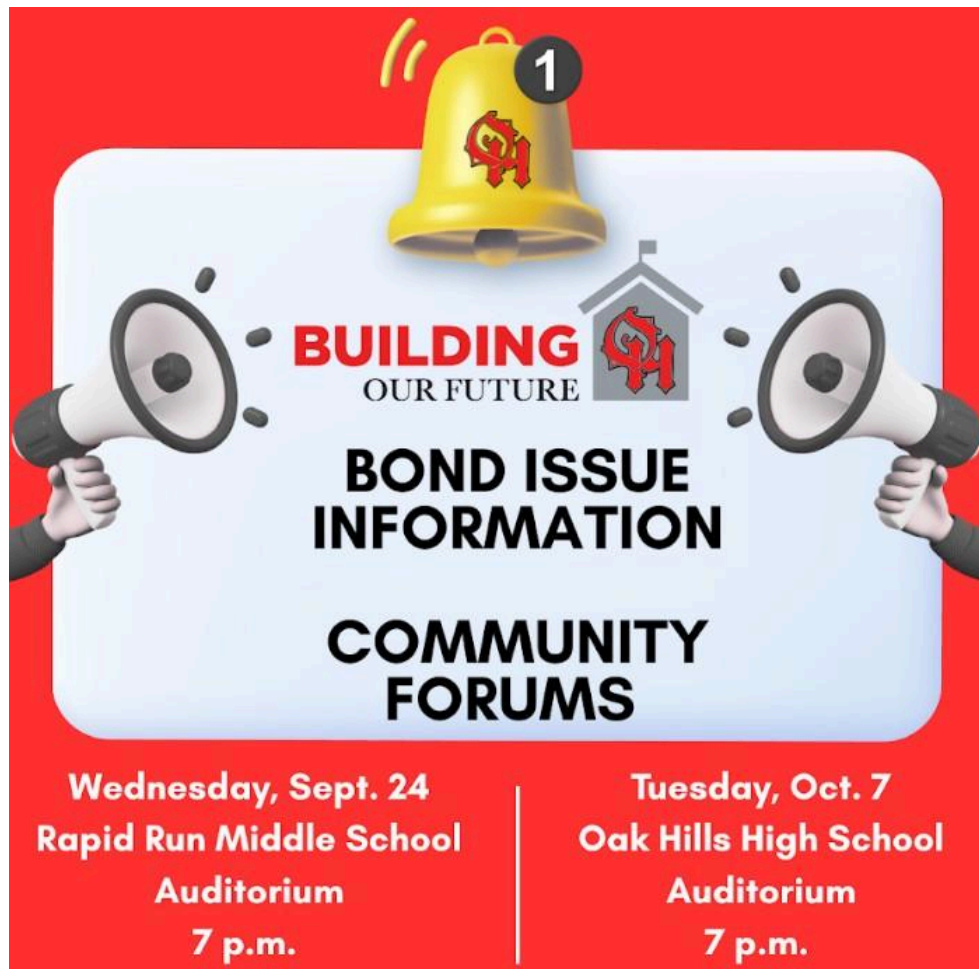

## Bond Issue



Oak Hills Local School District will host two community forums in the coming weeks to discuss the Bond Issue that will appear on the November 2025 ballot. These sessions are designed to provide parents, staff, students, and community members with important information and an opportunity to ask questions.

### **Attendees will:**

- Learn vital financial details about the Bond Issue and matching funds from the State of Ohio.
- Review plans to build three new schools and complete districtwide renovations in partnership with the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission.
- Gain insight into the current condition of district school facilities.
- Ask questions and engage directly with district leaders.

# Oak Hills General bond Info Sheet

## NOVEMBER 4, 2025 BOND ISSUE BY THE NUMBERS

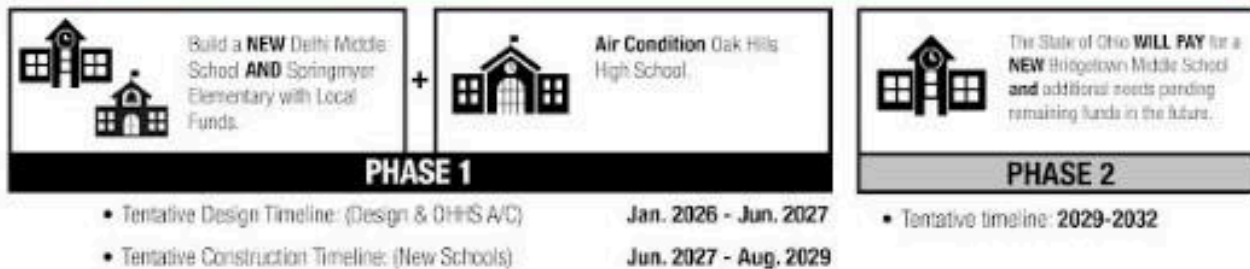


### 1 Why Build? Why Now?

- OHLSO is partnering with the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OFCC) to build three new schools, so over **50%** of the project would be funded by the State of Ohio in Phase 2.
- The District is projected to receive at least **\$70 MILLION** funded by the State in Phase 2.
- The District will **ONLY** get this funding if the community passes the bond issue to raise our local share first.
- Expiring 1997 Bond Millage equates to **ZERO net increase** in current property taxes to our residents.

### 3 How Much Will it Cost?

- **No tax increase.** Expiring funds from the 1997 Rapid Run Bond will be invested in new construction of Springmyer Elementary, Delhi Middle, and High School AC.
- The November 2025 bond issue is considered a new additional levy, however the taxes assessed today (for the 1997 bond issue) will **equal the taxes assessed for the new bond issue** becoming effective January 2026.

All of our OH All-Sports Pass and individual game ticket options are listed for our fans on the [oakhillssports.com](http://oakhillssports.com) website. We highly encourage students, parents, grandparents, family members, and all fans to purchase an OH All-Sports Pass for the 2025-26 school year as the OH All-Sports Pass gets you entry into all HOME Oak Hills High School, Bridgetown Middle School, Delhi Middle School, and Rapid Run Middle School athletic team events except tournaments for the entire school year. You will be sent 1 QR code for the school year and the processing fees are included in the pass prices.

Tickets can also be purchased with CASH or CREDIT CARD at the ticket gate. Tickets purchased online or at the ticket gate with a CREDIT CARD will be charged a processing fee.

For OHLSD Residents 65+ we also have the free Highlander Golden Card which works like an OH All-Sports Pass! Register and receive a card at OHHS in the Athletic Office or call Jen Armbruster at District Office at 513-574-3200 to set up an appointment!

**\*\*OHLSD Staff IDs may be used for entry into all HOME OHLSD school team athletic events except tournaments, however, you MUST show the ID at the ticket gate! Only the staff member will receive free entry.**
