

Review Unity, Coherence, and Logic

Definitions:

Unity: All statements **agree** with the main idea or main message.

Coherence: Ideas are connected using **transitions** to add flow.

Logic: Ideas are supported with **evidence**; they make sense.

Key Idea:

Unity, coherence, and logic create **internal consistency** in text.
