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Thank you for traveling to Seattle to attend Wheels of Fortune 12. We would like to make your experience as enjoyable as possible, so we have put together some basic information to help you.

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Wheels of Fortune 12 takes place on the traditional homelands of the Coast Salish Peoples, including the [Duwamish](#), [Suquamish](#), [Muckleshoot](#) and [Tulalip](#) Tribes. - At WOF, any skaters who identify as: *Girls, Women, Trans Femme, Trans Masc, Non-Binary, &/or Gender Expansive*, are welcome to compete in Sunday's contest.
- Skaters who identify as: *Queer, Girls, Women, Trans Femme, Trans Masc, Non-Binary, &/or Gender Expansive*, are welcome to skate on Saturday night's QWT Sk8 Jam.

 - Sign ups will take place after info session and onsite through WOF weekend.

WOF Code of Conduct:

- All ages and all genders are welcome at WOF, but not necessarily every single event. Please note the following specific guidelines:
 - QWT Jam is for Queer, Women, Trans, Non-binary, &/or Gender Expansive skateboarders
 - Sunday's contest is for Women, Trans masculine, Trans feminine, Non-binary, &/or Gender Expansive skateboarders.
 - Skaters who identify as Cisgender male are welcome to join:
 - SeaSk8 meetup, media orientation, welcome party, after party, Witch Hunt, Shop Hang, Wheels of Fingers & observe the Sunday competition.
- Skaters show up looking all sorts of different ways, and we ask that you not assume anyone's pronouns, identities, and/or sexuality. Come as you are and be prepared to practice asking for, sharing, and respecting each other's pronouns and identities.
- Follow all directions given by Skate Like a Girl staff and volunteers.
- Practice consent (We love F.R.I.E.S! **F**reely given, **R**eversible, **I**nformed, **E**nthusiastic, **S**pecific).
- Skaters under the age of 18 will be asked to wear a helmet when skating.
- Communicate appropriately by avoiding foul language, gestures, or unfriendly tones of voice.
- Be kind and do not cause deliberate physical and/or emotional harm to others, such as bullying.
- Treat the spaces and communities we are in with respect and care.
- Have fun and be yourself!

WOF Covid Protocol

- We ask that all participants be vaccinated or test negative within 48 hours of arrival. You can view all of our COVID policies at SkateLikeAGirl.com/COVID19.
- All participants (regardless of vaccination status) are strongly encouraged to test before attending each WOF event.
- If you test positive or begin to feel symptoms please stay home and do not attend WOF events.
- **Limited** rapid tests and PPE will be readily available. Please bring your own masks & tests so we can spread our resources further.

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Accommodation Recommendations:

Please note that Skate Like a Girl will **not** be facilitating skaters and attendees with finding free homestays. We encourage attendees to join our [Discord server](#) to connect with other WOF participants and coordinate lodging, transportation, travel, etc. on their own. Skate Like A Girl staff will be active on this server to answer any questions and provide more information, as needed.

Generally, we recommend staying in the **Fremont/Wallingford/Ballard/Green Lake areas (1 on the map)** if you are mostly at WOF for the Sunday competition. We recommend the **Queen Anne Neighborhood (3 on the map)** for anyone traveling with a car, as there is typically more parking available and it is centrally located. We recommend the **Capitol Hill/Central District (4 on the map)** for anyone traveling mostly for Witch Hunt/QWT Sk8 Jam or folks wanting to be close to nightlife. 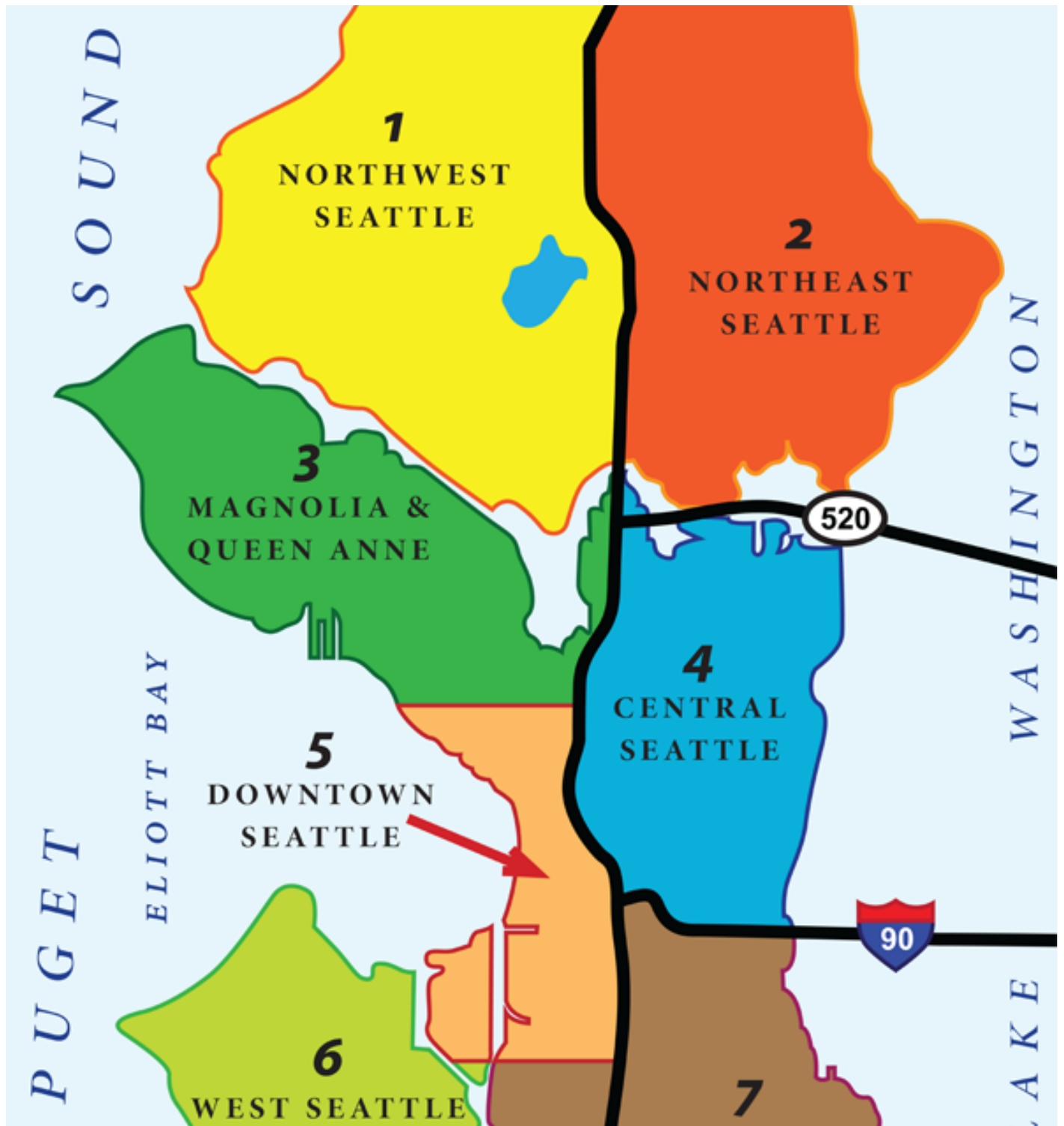

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Seattle Neighborhood Map

Area 1: Fremont, Wallingford, Ballard & Greenlake (Close to Sunday competition)

Area 3: Queen Anne (More parking available & centrally located)

Area 4: Capitol Hill & Central District (Close to Witch Hunt, QWT Sk8 Jam & nightlife)

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Transportation Tips:

- **Use Link Light Rail to get to/from SeaTac Airport** – Skate Like a Girl will not be providing official airport transportation or shuttles. **Due to traffic in the city, we highly recommend taking the light rail (1 Line) to/from the airport**, which has stops downtown, Capitol Hill, and the University District ([closest stop to All Together Skate Park](#)), among other stops (see image below). To get from SeaTac to the University of Washington stop, it costs approximately \$3.25 and will take about an hour.
- **To pay for a one-way or all day ticket in-person**, you will need to use a card or exact change at a *ticket machine* (see right image), which are located at every Link light rail station. **To pay for a one-way or all-day electronic ticket**, you can download the [Transit GO App](#) to purchase and use tickets from your phone ahead of time. The Link light rail runs approximately every 10 minutes, [here is a link to view real-time schedules](#).

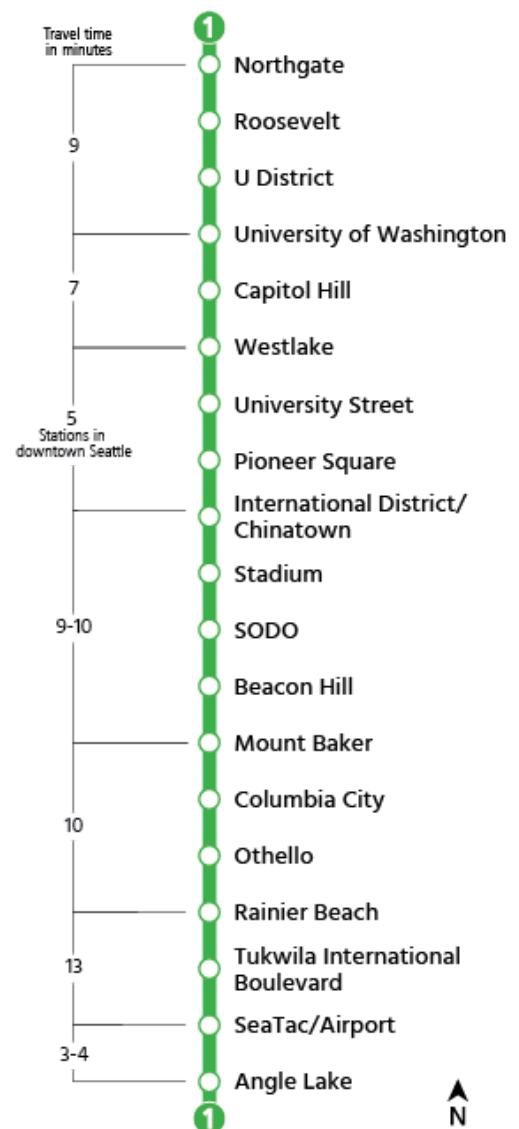


- **Public transportation** - We have a good number of light rail and bus lines that travel from the Downtown area to the event neighborhood of Fremont. For easy trip planning, **download Google Maps and OneBusAway to get you around town on public transit**. Please note that you will need access to the internet and/or mobile data to see live updates. The combination of these two apps will get you anywhere in Seattle:

-  **Google Maps App** – Type in where you want to go and select the departure/arrival time. You have the option to choose public transportation. This will tell you when and where you should catch the bus/light rail.

-  **OneBusAway App** - This app shows you your stop, when the bus will arrive, and which side of the street you should be on to catch the bus.

- **Lyft or Uber Apps** – If you are uncomfortable using public transit, we highly recommend these car service apps for getting around town affordably. Download the app to get started! Please note that these apps require a credit card on your account.
- **Lime, Veo, or Bird Bike/Scooter Apps** – For getting around the Fremont area, we recommend the use of the various bike & scooter share companies. These are great for short trips in lieu of a car. You can find e-bikes and scooters lying around on nearly every corner. Download the app to get started! Please note that these apps require a credit card on your account.
- **Parking** during Sunday's Competition and Vendor Village: [Stone 34 Parking Garage](#) will be open from 9AM-10PM 3400 Stone Way N, Seattle, WA 98103
Parking Rates: 1 HR = \$4.00, 1-2 HRS = \$7.00, 2-3 HRS = \$11.00, 3-10 HRS = \$15.00, 10 HRS- CLOSING = \$20.00 (All taxes + fees included in prices)
