To qualify a student must:

be 17 or older
lack a secondary (high school) credential and/or function below the 12th grade
level in any of the basic academic areas, including reading, math, and the ability to
read, write and understand English

Tips/Reminders:

Referring students <u>before</u> they are dropped due to attendance or the school year
ends is more successful
Call us to talk about your student's situation before you meet with them and their
parents. Feel free to give the student and/parents our office number so they can
ask any questions you may not know.
15 day drops still apply to our program. They have to attend in person for tests.
Transfer home school enrollment to Great Rivers Adult Education K12 diploma with
Student Information. If they decide GED/HiSET it will be a withdrawal form.

BEST FIT STUDENTS:

- Fewer than 10 credits remaining
- Student who is self-motivated and responsible
- Has transportation to DPC
- Struggle with traditional classroom settings and want to work at their own pace
- Schedule doesn't work with the SWAHS program (parents, working to support family, etc.)
- Someone who fell behind due to a medical or family issue and won't fully catch up
- Someone who needs more individualized teacher support

NOT A GOOD FIT:

- trying to get done as fast as possible
- lacking motivation to study on their own
- requiring a lot of support to get through coursework
- with a lot of credits to finish
- Doesn't have transportation-SWAHS may be a better fit if they need transportation
- Adult Ed does not provide special services. IEP's get dropped at transfer.
