Abstract (Arabic or English)

Abstracts must be clear, factual, and briefly describe the contents of the article, such as the background of the problem (maximum 2 sentences), research objectives, research methods, findings, conclusions. meaning of using ambiguous sentences. Abstract must be written in 2 languages, English or Arabic with a length of approximately 150-200 words, using Times New Roman 12 pt and Sakka Majalla 16 pt for Arabic with 1 space.

A. PENDAHULUAN/ INTRODUCTION/ المقدمة

The introduction must contain the background of the problem based on data in the field as well as the results of a review of several literatures relevant to the research theme. The literature review and explanation of the main ideas of this research should be explained in a concise and precise manner.

B. METODE PENELITIAN/ METHOD/ منهجية البحث

Materials and methods should enable the reader to reproduce the experiment. Provide sufficient detail to allow the work to be reproduced. Published methods must be indicated by reference: only relevant modifications should be described. Do not repeat the details of an existing method. **Describe the research methods used in the form of a paragraph, up to 3 paragraphs.**

Subsection Identification

It is conventional and wise to divide the Methods section into labeled subsections. This usually includes a section with a description of the participant or subject and a section describing the procedures used in the study. The final section often includes a description of (a) any experimental manipulation or intervention used and how it is delivered—for example, any mechanical equipment used to deliver it; (b) sampling procedures and sample size and precision; (c) the measurement approach (including the psychometric properties of the instruments used); and (d) research design. If the research design is complex or the stimulus requires a detailed description, additional subsections or subheadings to divide the subsections may be needed to help the reader find specific information.

Include in this subsection important information for understanding and replicating the research. Inadequate detail leaves the reader wondering; too much detail burdens the reader with irrelevant information. Consider using attachments and/or additional websites for more detailed information.

Characteristics of Participants (Subjects)



Identification of appropriate research participants is critical to the science and practice of psychology, particularly for generalizing findings, making comparisons across tests, and using evidence in research synthesis and secondary data analysis. If humans participate in this study, please report eligibility and exclusion criteria, including any limitations based on demographic characteristics.

Research design

Specify the research design in the Methods section. Is the subject placed in a manipulated state, or is it observed in a naturalistic way? If multiple conditions are created, how are participants assigned to conditions, via random assignment or other selection mechanisms? Was the research conducted as an inter-subject or in-subject design?.

C. HASIL DAN PEMBAHASAN/ RESULT AND DISCUSSION/نتيجة البحث والمناقشة

Results should be clear and concise. The results should summarize (scientific) findings rather than providing data in great detail. Please highlight any differences between your results or findings and previous publications by other researchers. **The research results must be supported by relevant theory.** The table format can be seen from the following example:

This section should explore the significance of the research results. A combined Findings and Discussion section is also appropriate. This section allows you to offer your interpretation and explain the meaning of your results. Emphasize the theoretical or practical consequences of the results.

The Discussion section should be a reasonable and justifiable comment on the importance of your findings. This section states why the issue is important; what is the bigger problem and what propositions are confirmed or not confirmed by extrapolating these findings to the overarching problem.

D. KESIMPULAN/ CONCLUSION/الاختصار

Conclusions must answer the research objectives. Tells how your work advances the field from the current state of knowledge. Without a clear conclusion, reviewers

and readers will find it difficult to judge the work, and whether the work is worthy of publication in the Proceedings or not. Do not repeat the Abstract, or only include experimental results. Provide a clear scientific justification for your work, and point out possible applications and extensions. You should also suggest future experiments and/or indicate ongoing experiments

REFERENSI

Any sources cited in the body of the article must appear in the Bibliography, and all sources that appear in the Bibliography must be cited in the footer (footnote) of the article. **The minimum number of references used is 20 references. 80% of the references come from research journals published in the last 10 years. It is preferred to use references from international publications.** The sources cited are primary sources in the form of journal articles, proceedings, research reports including theses and dissertations. References must be presented alphabetically and chronologically and set to 12-pt times new roman font, justified, with single-line spacing and hanging indents. Check every reference to the original source (name of author, volume, edition, year, DOI number). **Please use the ZOTERO or MENDELEY** Reference Manager App. Use other articles published in the same Proceedings as models. Citations and references must follow the style of the **Modern Humanities Research Association 3rd edition**.
