The Delaware Smile Check Program is a statewide, portable community preventive dental program dedicated to improving health outcomes through disease prevention, oral health education, and resolving barriers to care through case management.



# **On-Site Services**

- Dental Screenings: A licensed dental hygienist will check for signs of infection, cavities, gum problems, trauma, malformations or abnormalities in the teeth or tissues of the mouth.
- Fluoride Varnish: A fluoride application to strengthen teeth against decay and reverse early
  cavities
- Dental Health Education: Customized education and resources to address the needs of each patient.
- Oral Health Evaluation Report: Dental screening report form sent home with the student.
- Case Management: Connect with families to assist in navigating the complexities of the health
  care system, connect to resources and assist with finding solutions for barriers to care they
  identify.
- Dental Necessities: Toothbrush, fluoride toothpaste, and dental floss.

### **Virtual Services Offered**

- Dental Screenings: A licensed dental hygienist will check for signs of infection, cavities, gum problems, trauma, malformations or abnormalities in the teeth or tissues of the mouth through a virtual screening.
- Dental Health Education: Customized education and resources to address the needs of each patient
- Case Management: Connect with families to assist in navigating the complexities of the health care system, connect to resources and assist with finding solutions for barriers to care they identify.

## Who can participate?

- Anyone insured by Delaware Medicaid, Delaware Healthy Children Program, or has no dental insurance.
- Age three-months-old and up.
- Those who have not received an exam, cleaning, or fluoride in the last seven months.



What is the cost?

There is no out of pocket expense for any service provided.

The Delaware Smile Check Program believes every child deserves a healthy mouth and smile. Dental services are available to students who have no dental insurance, are insured by Delaware Medicaid or Delaware Healthy Children Program, and have not received routine dental care (dental cleaning, examination, fluoride) in the past 7 months.

The program is offered at your child's school on February 15, 2023 where a licensed dental hygienist will complete a dental screening (a visual evaluation), fluoride varnish application to strengthen teeth, and assistance with locating resources and treatment options for your child if needed.

Sign up your child by clicking the link or scan the QR code that includes the age of your child to complete the registration forms. Families will not receive a bill for services provided and children that participate will receive a toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss, and a prize.
