**Course Description:**

**This course is the 4th year of Tech Theatre.** Theatrical Management and Design is the advanced level course within the Arts, Media and Entertainment Production and Managerial pathway. This course offers the technical theatre student advance studies in management as well as research and design. Building on the previous two years of training, students will provide leadership in theatrical productions from design to execution. Examples include pre-production duties, front of house operations and creating design portfolios. Students will demonstrate mastery of Career Technical Educational Arts, Media and Entertainment State Standards as well as Visual and Performing Arts and Common Core State Standards. Students will synthesize and evaluate the connection between theatrical arts and core curriculum in order to successfully pursue college and career paths in the industry.

This course meets the CSU / UC visual and Performing arts requirement.
