- 1) PLT (Personalized Learning Time)- Class time used to work on Focus Area's for the four core content areas (Math, English, History, & Science).
 - a. Counts for 30% of your grade in each class.
 - i. Completion of ALL "Power Focus Areas" makes up 21% of your grade.
 - ii. Completion of "Additional Focus Areas" can raise your grade up to 9%.
 - iii. Completion of "Challenge Focus Areas" do not affect your grade.
 - b. Must complete all "Power Focus Areas" to pass the class
 - c. Each "Additional Focus Area" completed will raise your grade
 - d. All "Challenge Focus Areas" are for you to do when the time is right to deepen your learning in the content area.
 - e. ***IMPORTANT*** Students will have the following times to work on PLT:
 - i. PLT Class- One period Monday through Thursday
 - ii. PLT Fan Out Friday- Every Friday from 8:20am to 12:00pm
 - iii. AFTER SCHOOL- The school will be open from 3:10pm to 4:40pm every Monday through Thursday for students to work on their PLT playlists.
- 2) Project Time- Class time used for students to deepen their learning about the four core content areas through multiple projects throughout the school year. Students will work individually, in partners, small groups, and whole groups.
 - a. Students are graded on ALL Projects using the "Cognitive Skill Rubric" in all core content areas.
 - b. Students must complete each checkpoint and receive feedback and approval from teacher before moving on to next checkpoint.
 - c. Students have the opportunity to raise their "Cog. Skill Score" throughout the project and in other projects (If it is assessed multiple times.
 - d. ***IMPORTANT*** Students "Cognitive Skill Average" must be at their grade level to pass the course.
- 3) Mentoring- Weekly meetings throughout the school year with your mentor to discuss both your academics and life. Goals will be set for long term and weekly around your academic progress and other things that you choose.
 - a. Mentoring takes place each Friday morning during "Fan Out Friday" PLT time.
 - b. When not meeting with their mentor, student will work individually for PLT.
- 4) Chromebooks- These devices are assigned to you to assist you throughout the learning journey. They are to be taken care of and remain on campus at all times. Use them to your advantage and make good choices.
 - a. Each student is assigned a numbered Chromebook.
 - b. ***IMPORTANT*** Treat your Chromebook with care, we can't replace 80 of them.
 - i. Always get your Chromebook at the start of school every day.
 - ii. Be sure to transport your Chromebook carefully in the hallways and store it in a safe location.
 - iii. Always turn off the Chromebook and PLUG IT IN at the end of every day.
