Prizes:

Length - five to six typewritten pages, double-spaced, student name on each page, please number the pages.

Rubric -

- €the essay should be written in English using proper spelling, grammar, and essay structure
- €information must be accurate
- €research must be evident, and a bibliography of sources must be included
- €footnotes should be properly used when necessary
- €creativity is a requirement
- €essay must be in the student's own words
