FCPS Book Study Guidelines & Facilitator Responsibilities

With principal, supervisor and/or content/curriculum specialist approval <u>and</u> the completion of the <u>FCPS Book Study Proposal</u>, individual schools, feeder patterns, departments or content areas may be approved to offer a book study as an MSDE credit-bearing professional learning experience for staff.

Book Study Guidelines:

- 1. Select a text that is responsive to the unique and varied needs of staff, schools and communities.
- 2. Structure the book study as a **15-hour** professional learning experience (15 hours =1 MSDE CPD credit/15 PDPs).
- 3. Group meeting times must occur beyond normal work hours.
- 4. Book studies may be designed as "hybrid" activities a mix of face-to-face experiences (at least 21%) and online discussions (as much as 79%). Face-to-face may occur synchronously using Google Meet. *If schools choose the hybrid format, the facilitator should have training/experience in using an online platform for instructional purposes.*
- 5. An FCPS staff member, who has completed the FCPS Book Study Facilitator Training, must serve as the facilitator for the book study.
- 6. No fee is charged.
