Overview Productivity Guard is a Chrome extension designed to help users manage their productivity by blocking distracting websites. This privacy policy outlines what data we collect, how we use it, and your rights as a user.

What Information We Collect

- **Blocked and Paused Sites:** We store the websites you add to your blocked or paused lists. This data is saved locally on your device using Chrome's storage API.
- **No Personal Data:** We do not collect any personally identifiable information, such as your name, email address, or IP address.
- **No Web History Tracking:** Productivity Guard does not track or collect your browsing history or monitor the content of the websites you visit.

How We Use Your Data

- The data we collect (blocked and paused websites) is used solely to provide the core functionality of the extension.
- We do not share or sell this data to third parties.

User Rights

- You have full control over the data stored by the extension. You can add, modify, or delete blocked or paused sites directly within the extension.

- Productivity Guard may contain links to third-party websites, such as Buy Me a Coffee. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of these external sites.
