Program Description

The Bachelor in Film Production at HBI University provides students with hands-on training in all aspects of filmmaking, including directing, screenwriting, cinematography, editing, and production management. This program equips students with the skills necessary to create compelling narratives and visual storytelling across multiple media platforms.

The Minor in Faith-Based Documentary Filmmaking and Media Activism enhances this degree by integrating Christian ethics and faith-driven storytelling into film production. Students will explore documentary filmmaking as a tool for social change, media advocacy in faith-based movements, and the ethical considerations of producing faith-inspired films.

Capstone Project (15 Credit Hours)

The capstone project in Film Production allows students to create a professional-quality film or documentary that integrates storytelling, technical filmmaking skills, and faith-based themes. Students will:

- Produce a documentary exploring a social justice issue from a faith-based perspective.
- Create a short film with a narrative centered on Christian values and ethics.
- Develop a media advocacy campaign using film as a platform for change.
- Present their final project to faculty, media professionals, and community leaders.

- Integrate faith-based perspectives into documentary filmmaking and media activism.
- Utilize film as a tool for advocacy, education, and social justice.
