Zoopla Terms and Conditions

Festive Homes Competition November 2021-December 2021

1. The Promoter

The promoter is: Zoopla Limited of The Cooperage, 5 Copper Row, London, England, SE1 2LH.

2. The competition

- 2.1 The title of the competition is Zoopla Festive Homes competition.
- You may be eligible to win a £500 homeware voucher by submitting photographs of your home dressed for Christmas through the form on the Promoter's website, found here.

3. How to enter

- 3.1 The competition will run from 00:01 (Greenwich Mean Time) on 24 November 2021 (the "Opening Date") to 23:59 (Greenwich Mean Time) on 13 December 2021 (the "Closing Date") inclusive.
- 3.2 All competition entries must be received by the Promoter by no later than the time on the Closing Date. All competition entries received after 23:59 on the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.
- 3.3 To enter the competition, submit an original photograph (**"Content"**) taken by you of our home dressed for Christmas through the form on the Promoter's website, found here.
- 3.4 We regret that we are unable to accept postal entries.
- 3.5 The Promoter will **not** accept:
 - (a) responsibility for competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
 - (b) proof of transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the competition.
- 3.6 By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

- 3.8 The competition entries will be shortlisted by Aira Digital Limited ("Aira"), the Promoter's digital marketing agency. Aira will then submit their shortlist to the Promoter, who will decide the winner. The winning entry will be the Content that is judged on creativity and the ability to spread festive cheer. The decision of the panel of judges will be final.
- 3.9 The Promoter will send the full names of the judges to anyone who writes within one month after the Closing Date of the competition requesting details of the judges and who encloses a self-addressed envelope to the address set out in Condition 1.
- 3.10 No purchase necessary and there is no charge to register for use of the website.

4. Eligibility and Parental Consent

- 4.1 The competition is only open to all residents in the UK aged 18 years or over, **except**:
 - (a) employees of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies;
 - (b) employees of agents or suppliers of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with the competition or its administration; or
 - (c) members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.
- 4.2 In entering the competition, you confirm that:
 - (a) You are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the competition.
 - (b) The Content will not include the following:
 - (i) images of a minor;
 - (ii) street signs; or
 - (iii) door numbers

- 4.7 The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.

5. The prize

- 5.1 The prize is a £500 John Lewis voucher.
- 5.2 Prizes are subject to availability. There is no cash alternative for the prize.

- 6.3 The Promoter must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the Promoter will send the surname and county of the prize winner and, if applicable a copy of their winning entry, to anyone who emails zoopla@aira.net or writes to the address set out in Condition 1 (enclosing a self-addressed envelope) within one month after the Closing Date of the competition.

In such circumstances, the Promoter must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

- 7.2 The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.

7.3 The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed their prize within 7 days of the Announcement Date, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the entries that were shortlisted for the prize.

8. Limitation of liability
