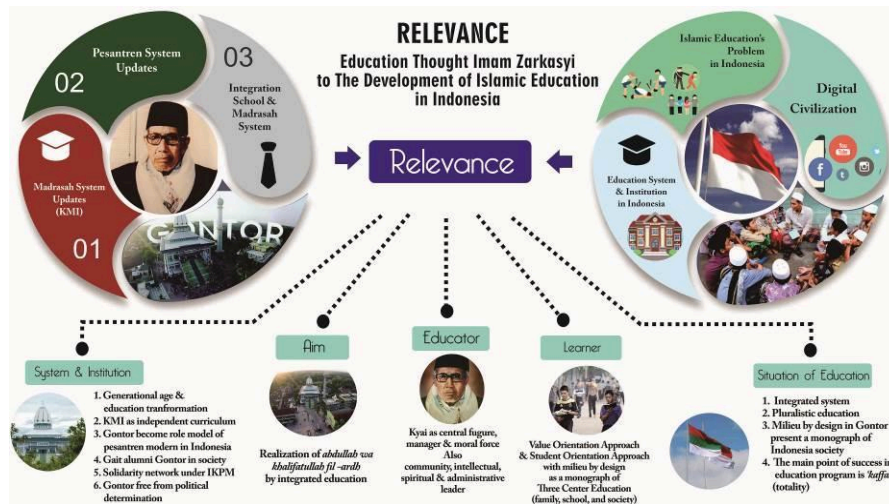


Figure 1. The Scheme of Relevance to The Development of Islamic Education in Indonesia (Exp for diagram)
