Sesquicentennial (1997) Batch Scholarships for academic excellence

INSTRUCTIONS

This award is to recognize and honour the students having excellent academic performance. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 50,000/- each per year to the students of B.Tech/B.Arch., one each from 2nd, 3rd and 4th year, for academic excellence.

ELIGIBILITY

All 2nd, 3rd and 4th year students of B.Tech./B.Arch. having a minimum CGPA of 8.0.

SELECTION PROCESS

The following procedure will be adopted to select the deserving student for this award:

- SCSP office will invite the applications from the interested students at individual level. The applicants having at least one research publication in a conference/journal among their respective class will be awarded this scholarship, otherwise the applicants with the highest CGPA among their respective class will be awarded this scholarship. The applications must accompany supporting documents for the claims made.
- The Committee will select the students based on highest CGPA. In case, an applicant has published/presented at least one paper in a Conference/Journal in a year, he/she should be preferred over the applicant with the highest CGPA.

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

To apply for this award, the following documents are mandatory to submit:

- Supporting documents about your involvement in different activities related to research work/ publication.
