Gift Aid

Are you a UK taxpayer? If so, every £1 you give could be worth £1.25 to us, helping to fund vital work at no cost to you. All you need to do is tick the box below.

I understand that I need to pay enough Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax in each tax year to cover the Gift Aid claimed on all my donations to charity, otherwise it is my responsibility to pay any difference.

Gift Aid - increase the value of your subscription without paying a penny more

- Making a Gift Aid declaration is an easy way of allowing Lytham Town Trust to reclaim the tax you have already paid.
- Your membership subscriptions and/or donations are worth a quarter more, for example for every £10 you give, we can reclaim £2.50 from HM Revenue & Customs.
- Anyone who pays UK Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax can make a Gift Aid declaration.
- One Gift Aid declaration will cover all your future donations and membership subscriptions. If your tax circumstances change, or if you do not wish Gift Aid to apply to any specific donations, please contact us by email at secretary@lythamtowntrust.org.uk
- If you have previously made donations to Lytham Town Trust not covered by a Gift Aid declaration, you can backdate this declaration for up to 4 years if you were a UK taxpayer at the time. If you would like to do this, please email us at secretary@lythamtowntrust.org.uk
