Thank you for joining the Build Back Fossil Free week of action! We're calling on President Joe Biden to protect and invest in the Black, Indigenous, Brown, and working-class communities, to end the era of fossil fuel production, and to launch a national climate mobilization to Build Back Fossil Free. Through this week of action, we will highlight the <u>specific actions</u> President Biden should take now, and demonstrate that there is broad support for these policies across the country.

If you haven't already, please <u>use this form to sign up for the week of action</u>. This will allow us to share updates and send you materials as necessary. Then read the rest of this document for instructions and tips on planning your action.

Because of COVID, we won't be able to organize large events. But we can each organize a small, safe event in our community. Together our actions and photos will show that the mandate that ushered Biden into office has only gotten stronger.

- 1. Pick a time and place to gather outdoors where you can take photos and video.
 - a. The week of action is Monday Feb 8 to Sunday Feb 14. Pick a day that works for you and others that may join you.
 - b. Gather for a photo in front of a specific fossil fuel project, go to a Congress member's district office, an iconic landmark in your area, or a high-visibility place like an intersection or overpass.
 - c. Invite your crew: ask others in your area to join. Small gatherings are best, and everyone should wear a mask. More tips on staying safe on page 2.
- 2. Prepare visuals that convey your message to President Biden: Build Back Fossil Free!
 - a. We are asking everyone take a picture of you holding a sign that says President Biden, #BuildBackFossilFree, and what you are fighting against. A few examples:

- b. Bring signs or banners to your action that will be clearly visible in photos and to the public. They should incorporate the Build Back Fossil Free message to President Biden, and tie in local fossil fuel campaigns.
- c. You can also customize and print these posters from home: black and white, and color!
- 3. Write a press advisory and press release (if applicable)
 - a. If you're planning a public action, use this template <u>advisory</u> and <u>release</u> to inform the media.
- 4. Take action! Gather with your crew and visuals for a photo or quick rally.
 - a. Be sure to take at least one photo that clearly shows your group, visuals, and your location. A short video with remarks or chants ("Biden: Build back fossil free!") would be great too.
 - b. This guide has some tips for good event photos and video.
 - c. Share photos and video on social media with the hashtag #BuildBackFossilFree. You can also tag @JoeBiden, @POTUS, and @ginamccarthy, in addition to any other decision makers or local groups. See sample social media posts on pages 2-3.
 - d. Please also submit photos and videos using this form.



Organizing during a pandemic & climate crisis

- All participants should wear a mask at all times. Masks save lives. Please make sure that all
 participants are wearing masks during your action.
- Keep participants physically distanced from one another at all times. The <u>Center for Disease</u>
 <u>Control guidelines</u> are that people maintain six feet of physical distance from one another. Please keep
 participants in your action socially distanced.
- Don't go inside. It is imperative that we don't put others at risk with our actions. Please plan your
 action at an outdoor location where a small group of people can safely meet and gather.
- Do NOT plan a mass mobilization action. We know that actions can be powerful even with smaller numbers of people. We encourage you to NOT plan actions with large numbers of people at this time, but instead participate in this COVID safe action by keeping your group small.
- **Do NOT engage in actions that have a risk of arrest.** People who are imprisoned are among the most vulnerable in our society. Don't put them at further risk by getting yourself arrested at this action.
