

My experience with ImAllexx:

Though we never confirmed it to the public (because I personally like keeping my relationships private), I dated Alex from June 2017 till March 2018. It was the most toxic relationship I've ever been in, and I was lucky to get out of it when I did.

When we were dating (though he was from England and I lived in America) we were pretty much never apart for longer than a week. We stayed in Europe for a couple of months, then went to America for 6 months. He couldn't stay 6 months straight due to visa implications, so he stayed 3 months; flew back to England for a few days; then came back to America for another 3 months.

After this 6 months was over (and he couldn't come to America again for a while due to visa requirements), we spent some time away from each other. And during that time, with help of my friends, I came to the realization that I was in the worst and most toxic relationship I had ever been in, and I had to get out.

It started out great, as they always do, the honeymoon phase as they call it, but as time went on, things just got worse and worse. I was fortunate to get out when I did, but reading all the new information that's come out, he's clearly gotten worse.

During the relationship, he made me feel insane, like I wasn't myself anymore. It never felt like he listened to me. I always felt belittled and inferior. Whenever we recorded videos together, he would constantly talk over me and never let me have my moment.

Most of the time when I had problems, he always somehow made it about himself, or talked about his own issues. He would get stressed over his youtube channel constantly, and complain about uploading - as if it was the hardest job on the planet, and no one had it harder than him. His classic line was, "I can't catch a fucking break".

If we ever had a disagreement, he would also sometimes elude to the possibility of k*lling himself over minor conflicts as a threat, so I couldn't continue with the conversation. It was nearly impossible to give him any kind of criticism, because it was like adding to the pile of minor issues that he had already blown far out of proportion in his head.

Another thing he did was spin his own narrative and twist words. He didn't just do this in the relationship, but he did it in his work and with his friends. It was the main reason why many people stopped talking to him. Because we started to realize that when there was even the smallest amount of drama - and he heard about it - he would make sure to involve himself. Even if the subject had absolutely nothing to do with him, and he would just make everything so much worse.

For example, the Slazo situation. Though it was never said in the original statements by Chey, he somehow came to the conclusion that it was r*pe, and everyone else got the blame for saying his words. Somehow the situation went from being guilty of being a bad boyfriend, to all of a sudden he's a r*pist. This was the final nail in the coffin, and I cut all contact with him after that.

During our relationship, I bought him and I matching Alex and Ani [bracelets](#) for Valentine's Day because I was like: "Oh neat, a company with both our names". You can see him pressing the heart on the bracelet to his lips in his "back to nothing" video, which he has since taken down from his channel.

This video was released as a response to me breaking up with him. He uploaded this video after I stopped talking to him, as a way of trying to guilt me into replying to him.

He did to me what he has done in his relationship with Alice. Where he would fly off the handle and get mad, then act all apologetic and sad to try to get me to feel sorry for him, and forgive everything he had said and done.

Lastly, the only time he ever laid a finger on me, was when he grabbed me as I was trying to run away from a conflict. We were trying to record a Youtube video together, and he was getting frustrated at having to restart the recording multiple times. He started shouting and beating his fist on the table, even going as far as to break his microphone. I was scared, so I got up to leave the room, which is when he grabbed my arm to physically stop me. I remember saying, "you grabbed my arm" several times in shock, as if to say: 'who the fuck would ever grab someone like that?'

Once again, I was fortunate that that was the only time something like that ever happened. I got out before it got even worse, as it clearly has with the new information that's come out.

It saddens me that it's all come this far. I wished Alice the best privately and it breaks my heart to have seen all the things she had gone through. I hope Alice's and my story show you what he was really like behind the scenes. If you're in an abusive relationship, please get out now, you can't fix them.
