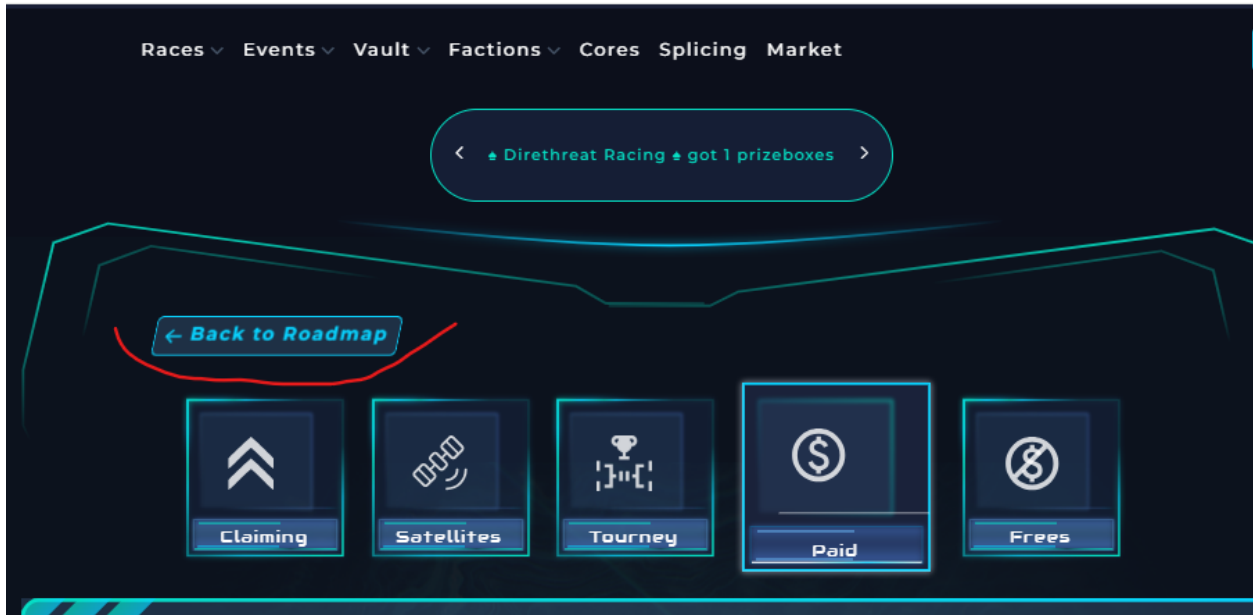


Life After Trainers

So you have progressed through your trainer core and want to keep racing and expand your vault. Well there are options ahead.

The roadmap will help guide you



You can go to the market and look to purchase a core. If you're looking to get some passive income then a Genesis core will provide that. If you're looking for a good winning core you can just filter through the market and check speeds & win rate statistics.

Generally you can look at the **Claimers** Tournament to pick up a decent core that you buy, run around, learn the game, hopefully profit & someone else may buy it. Making the whole process close to risk free.

The other option is to splice (Breed) a core. Create a core and test your splicing skill and luck and build a bloodline that could be premium.

The last option would be to the the splicing arena and choose Quick Select

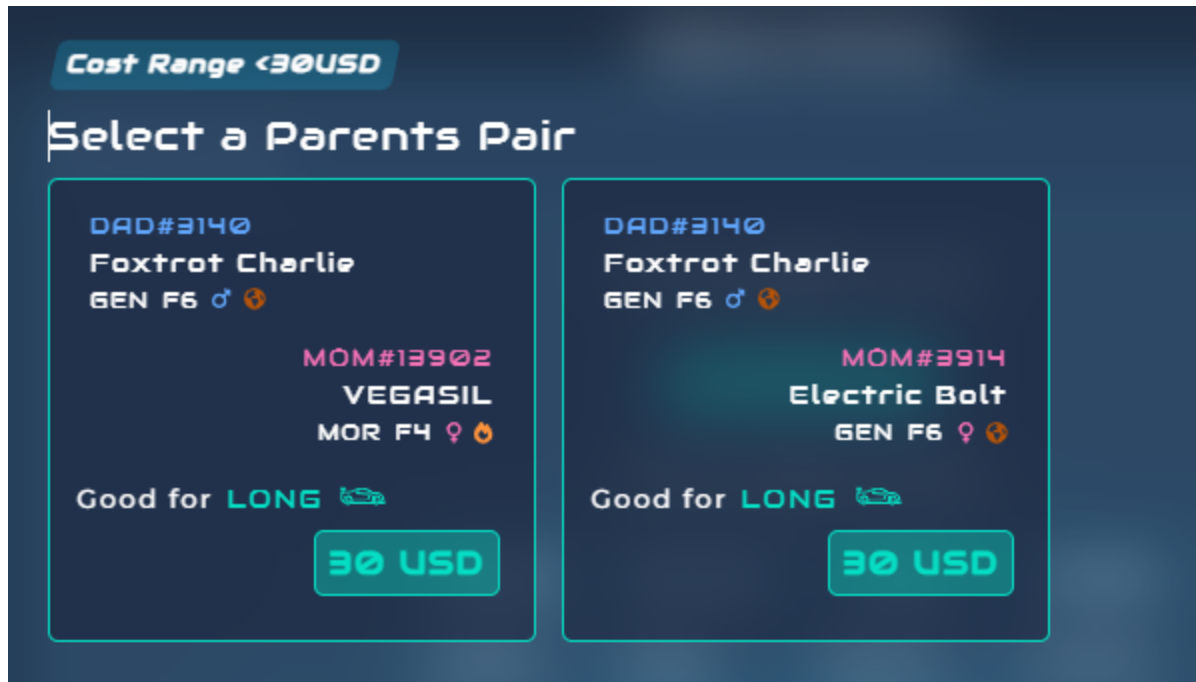

From here the game will pick 2 cores for you



DNA Racing is full of tournaments. There is paid racing in the lobby at all times but the fun thing to focus on is that every 3 to 5 days there are new tournaments happening.

It is important to pay attention to the different structures of each different tournament. Different structures require different types of traits from cores.

E.g - Top 3 requires a fast core that can place in the Top 3 positions fairly consistently out of a 12 gate field.

DU = Double Up requires that you are super consistently hitting good times to land 2nd and 3rd in a 6 gate field

Variance - These cores are hot and cold. They either place 1st, 2nd or are dead last. So the tournament points structure is set up for that.

My favourite is maiden where only new splice are eligible to enter. The prize pools of these are big and everyone wants to win it big!

Later on here I will show some charts with these traits and how to identify them.

Below is a typical season set up. There are other fun events happening throughout the season so there is always something to do.

Starting Small

So if you just finished up with a trainer core and are looking to start somewhere then I would suggest looking at the \$100 trainer tournament.

There are a few reasons for this..

1. You already know the structure of this tournament.
2. It's a cheap price point to get into the game
3. You will have to splice something for it.
4. Will be learning the splicing process
5. Could splice something with Arena potential to sell covers \$\$
6. Will be adding to & building out your vault
7. Will have a simple plan to build some data on

A good place to start is to understand that there are 4 different types of cores with different types of traits and an #F number system.

Metal, fire, earth & water

F1	METAL
F2	METAL
F3	FIRE
F4	FIRE
F5	EARTH
F6	EARTH
F7	WATER
F8	WATER

The F number system is fairly easy to work out. If you splice an F1 with an F1 your splice will be an F2. Splice two F8's together and your splice will be F16.

You just add the F numbers together. Yes there are 2 genders and splicing can only be done with a male and female.

A metal with metal will have metal offspring whereas if a metal and water will have an water offspring. The core element will always end up being the lowest element involved in the splice. This can be important because the DNA splicing fees are based on element and type.

The game has 6500 Genesis cores which are the building blocks of the game but there are 4 tier types of cores.

Once 2 genesis cores splice the offspring is then called a morphed core. Then if a morphed & genesis or morphed & morphed splice the offspring is then called a freak.

A freak can splice with a genesis or morphed core.

If the freak splices with a genesis core the offspring will also be a freak
(I call this holding the freak line)

If a freak splices with a morphed or another freak core then the offspring will be the 4th tier type of core called an Xclass.

Any splicing done with an Xclass will remain a XClass regardless of tier type.

This may be a bit confusing for now but trust me it will become 2nd nature in no time. All this is important as it all changes the DNA splice fee that you will pay. It will also determine the amount of splicing your core is able to do.

This is the splice fee table that shows what the DNA fee is for each element and type of core. The fee is based on the highest element/type that you will be splice with.

So 2 metal genesis cores will be \$40

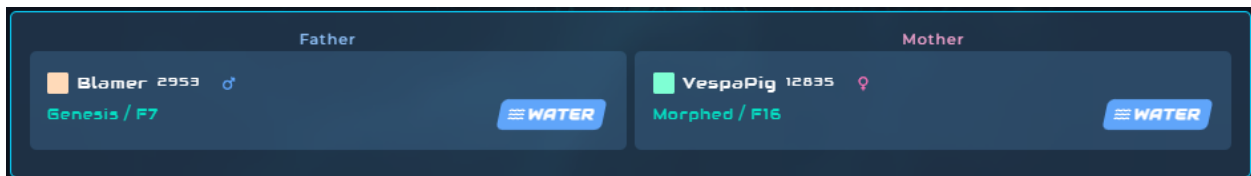
2 water genesis cores will be \$10

A water morphed with a metal genesis will be \$40 (Highest fee)
So this will impact your decision making.

Cycle times depend on core type
Male Genesis can splice 3 times and Female 1 per cycle
Genesis cycle resets every 45 days and spliced cores 60 days

What about the trainer tournaments?

Don't worry, I haven't forgotten about the trainer tournaments.
Now we know the way F numbers for splicing & elements/types for costs
work, we can start to put a plan together.
We need to make an F22 so which way should we go about it?



You can look for a good water morphed and splice with a water genesis.
This will create an F23 freak. I recommend trying to land around the F22
mark with your splices. Although I have seen some higher F numbers get in
the money.

Can you work out the DNA fee from this combination?

So it would be a base DNA fee of \$10 because the water genesis is the
highest tier type here.

Also i should mention that there is also the fee of owners of the cores.
The owner can place the core in the arena for whatever price they want.
Lets just say both these cores we \$5 each we would end up paying \$10 in
owner fees and \$10 DNA fee. So \$20 all up

If you own both cores you are the owner and will receive you funds back
making the total of this splice \$10

Can we make our cost back and profit?

Yes we can. I hit 1 win out of the first 65 races and won \$46.

I used both my cores so the splice this so the DNA fee was \$10

So made a profit of \$36

Also now I have this core in my vault. I may be able to enter this in the arena for \$5 or \$10 & hopefully someone will splice with it.

It is a freak so how many times can I splice this... 12

So let's splice and see how the whole process went?

Here you can see I put my freak with a water genesis so the base DNA fee was \$10. The owner price was \$10 and I own the female core which I put in for \$5 so the total cost was \$25. But I received \$5 back because I own the female so the total cost was \$20.

Note that genesis and freak will create a freak offspring. The offspring will be able to have 12 splices. (Holding the freak line)

Lets see if we made profit?

I hit two different tournament finals in the first 65 races and was able to make \$33.40

The cost of the core was \$20 so we profited \$13.40

Last trainer we made \$36 so now we are up \$49.40. Almost \$50

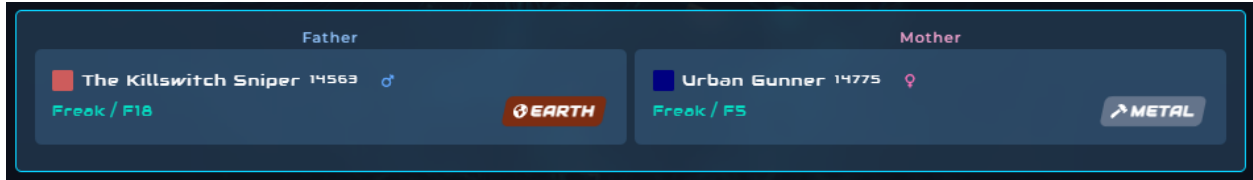
So now let's look at more splice combinations

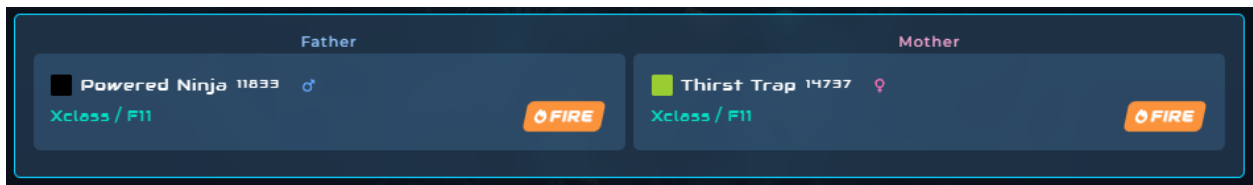

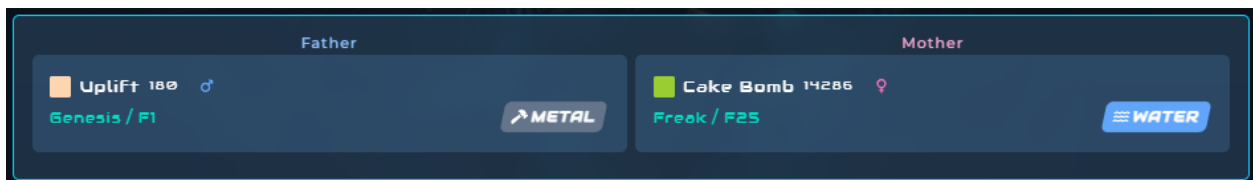
Then there is loading up a metal freak into earth (or water freak)
 See the F numbers F18 with low F5
 (\$14.4 Base DNA fee)



2 fire Xclass cores will be \$6.50 Base DNA fee
 There are similar splices with putting a morph or freak together as an F10
 with an F12 or F13 & F11 etc..

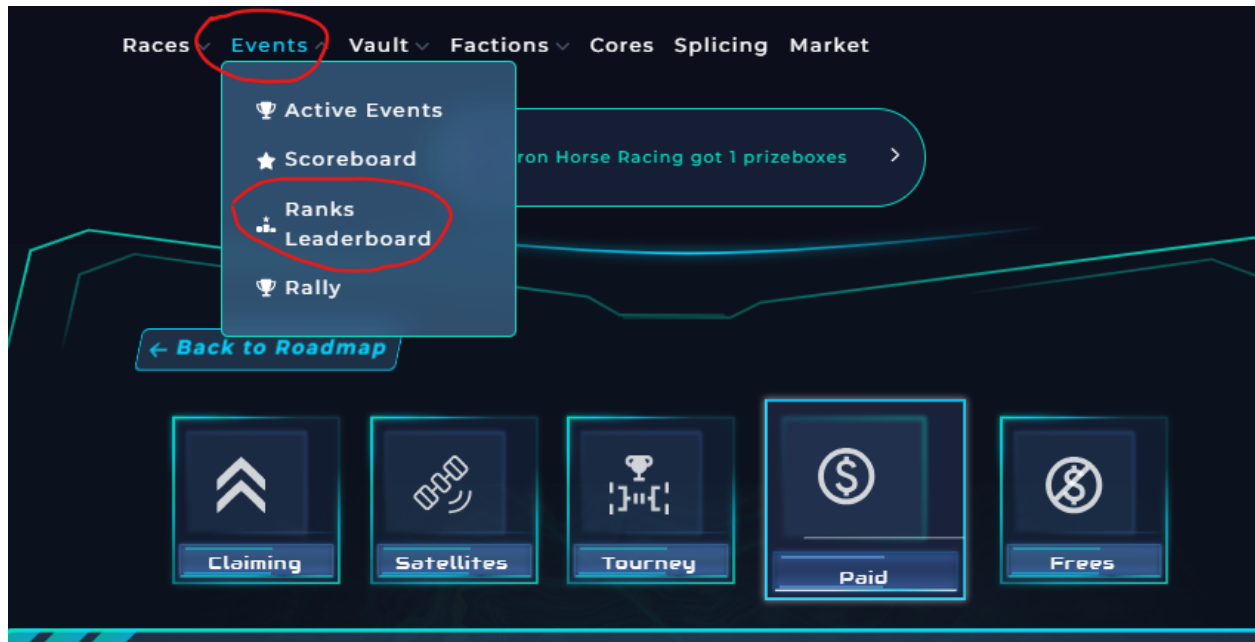
Ok so these are standard combinations and there are more. Try to match
 the distance preference and other traits like variance or stability.
 Take note of how splices turn out and what is producing the best outcomes
 for you. Try to rinse and repeat & get better and consistent results.

Finally you can also load up big into your trainer fleet but it just comes
 down to risk vs reward and what you are willing to risk.
 That's part of what makes this game so much fun.

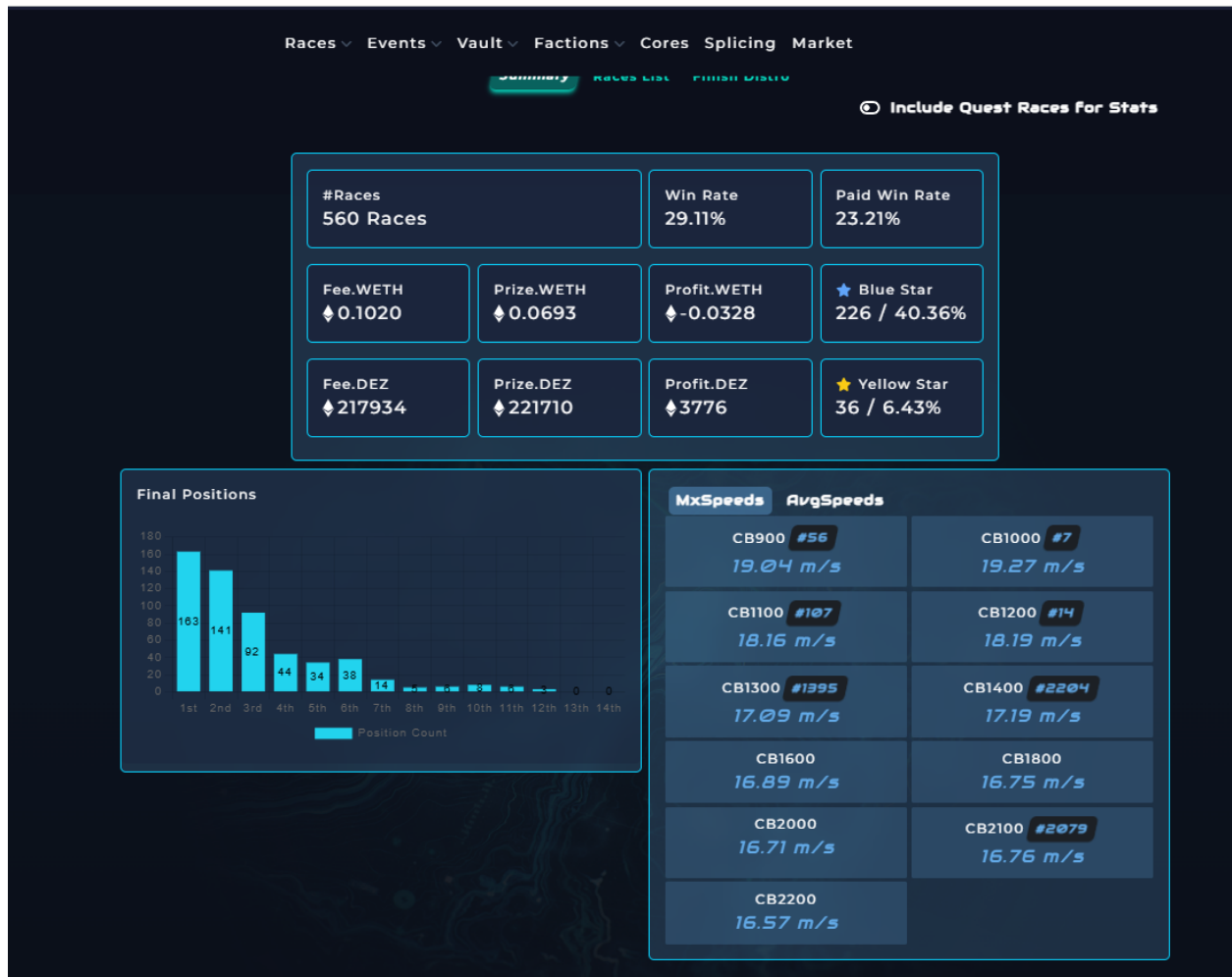

Under **Info** we can see a lot of statistics here and that he is in the arena for \$20. We can also see from our search that he is a water genesis. So splicing would also cost \$10 DNA fee.

We can check **All Races**

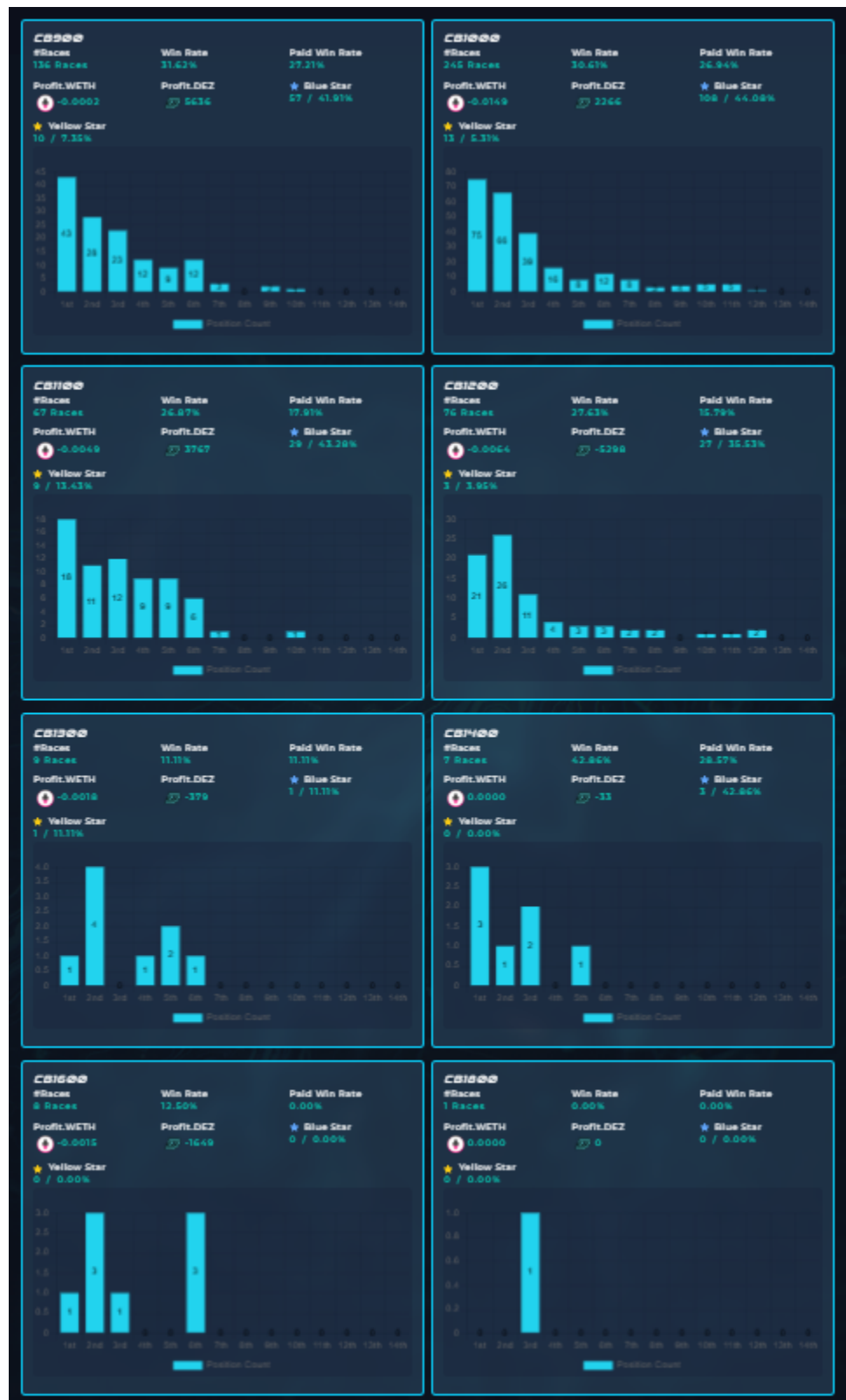


Here we can see the bar chart is leaning to the left which is good. Means it likes to win. Also the sprinter speeds are super low and almost all in the top 100 times.

So we can also check the **Finish Distribution**
 This shows bar charts for each individual distance.
 Distances are broken up into 3 segments
 1000m - 1200m are Sprints
 1400m - 1800m are Mids
 2000m - 2200m are Marathons

Cores can have distance preference so as the charts below we can Kickstart Thrive the sprint distance lean to the left.

As we get down to the mid and marathon distances we can see that it's not hitting 1st place with that nice frequency. Indicating the core is a sprinter .





So we should look for a female with a sprint distance preference (DP)
Now you go to ranks and search for that.

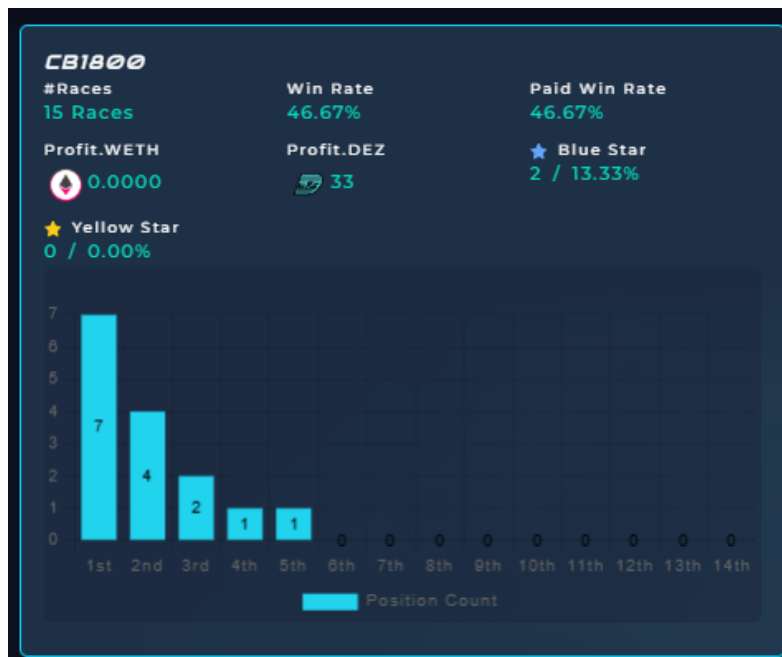
One tip is you may be watching a race or checking results, if you keep seeing the same core is beating you or having a good performance? Take notes, write its name down, check bloodlines, you might be able to splice with it or find there is an offspring you can splice with.
(Save you the need to filter through ranks)

Charts To Look Out For

We all want a beast so lets start there!



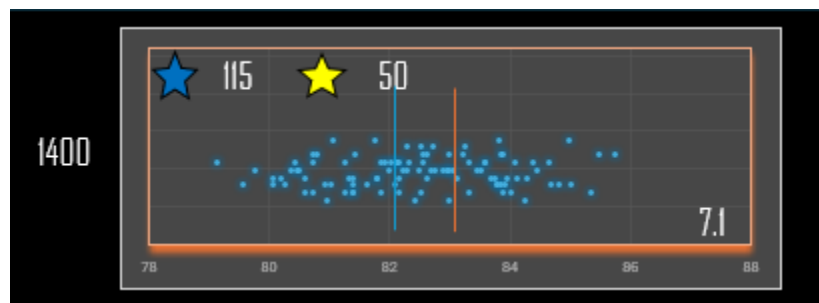
Yes you would want to splice with a core like this! This is a good sign. Identifying bar chart patterns early will help you figure out what kind of traits your core has.



The 2nd chart above could have potential to become a beast but could also mean the competition was easy. Do your research with times and what exactly the kind of races were? Free or Paid make a big difference. Be aware that stats may be padded somewhat meaning it looks good but is it really?



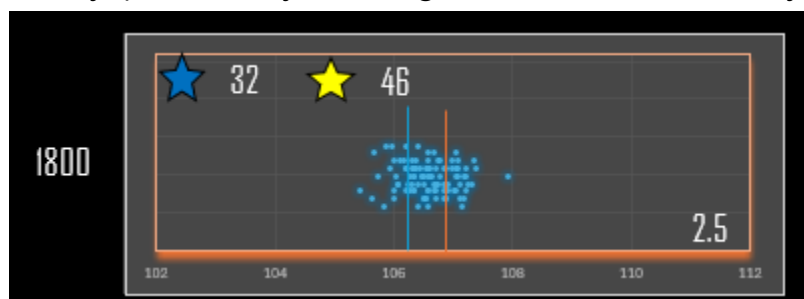
This is a variance pattern as you can see this core usually comes first or dead last. There are tournaments structured around this so that would be a good place to race this core.



These types of cores tend to have a large time distribution range and are not so predictable. They can be super fast or super slow.



This would be an ideal pattern for double up races or possible 2 gate WTA (Winner Take All) races? You can see from the distribution that 2nd, 1st & 3rd place have a higher frequency than 4th, 5th & 6th. Indicating high base ability (The ability to run good times consistently)



These types of cores tend to have small tighter time distributions with consistency.



This one is called the A shaper pattern for obvious reasons. Tend to come in the middle of the pack. Sometimes there are tournaments around this particular trait called Pity. I would not be going out of my way to splice with such a core but some do and they get success.



Then there is this pattern. You would not enter this type of core in a race to win. But sometimes there are reverse double up tournaments that run. You have the opportunity to travel this direction should you choose.

What Are Stars

When all the gates fill in a race, the race is then simulated thousands of times. From the results of all those races the stars are designated to certain cores.

So there is 1 blue star given out in 2 & 3 gate races. This indicates the core who got the most wins in the simulations.

Then from 4 gates onwards there is a blue and a yellow star. Again the blue indicates the most wins and the yellow indicates the most places (1st, 2nd & 3rd) in the simulations.

Then there are double stars. This means that out of all the simulations the 1 core had the most wins and the most places.

Blue represents variance in cores while the yellow indicates base ability somewhat to a degree.

Sometimes the stars don't always mean you will come 1st and you may end 4th or 5th or last even with double stars.

However when it comes to splicing I would be trying to follow the highest star rate cores I can. I believe in following the stars.



Hope this rundown helps give you an idea of how the splicing works and what to look for when trying to find your edge in the game.

I fully believe that if you get the trainers right and learn about building your vault out you will also have some success in other areas of the game & also have a great time.

Learn this and you can move on to the bigger tournament events with a clear direction of how you are going to go about it.
