## **Minutes**

We started our meeting by providing a budget update. We currently have \$28, 949.75. Since there are new members, Dr. Michael explained that the balance is due to efforts of the previous council and the school to ensure we had a decent amount of rollover from last year.

The site council is finally at full force. Our newest parent representatives and community member representatives were introduced. Now that these positions are filled. We will look to approve projects to fund.

Next we looked at where all previous agenda and minutes are housed. A link was provided if members want to review what we worked on previously.

One of the main responsibilities of the site council is to have an understanding of the school's Campus Improvement Plan. Dr. Michael went over the major areas of the plan. It was explained that these areas are in alignment with SUSD strategic plan. Additionally, there is a focus on Rigor, Academic Excellence, Climate and Culture, and Recruitment and Retention of staff.

Huge celebration - we are an A school!!!! It was pointed out that an immense amount of work goes into moving a school's letter grades. Major shoutout to our students, staff, and families for working in collaboration to achieve these gains.

The next part of the meeting was focused on the ongoing list of projects. Ultimately a priority list was created in this order:

There was a decision to wait on chairs. Dr. Micahael still expressed an interest in the video board. He updated the council stating that SUSD CFO will look into the status of what the new district standard will be. This will help us determine next steps.

It was also discussed that some students have provided feedback on the quality of the current water fountains. This is something we can look into.
