

Guide to [Prevent A Litter](#) Forms - Dog Spay/Neuter

Due to the extremely high demand for our surgery services, Prevent A Litter receives submissions through a Google Form '[Dog Spay/Neuter Request Form](#)' linked on our homepage for all routine dog spay and neuter requests. This form receives inquiries on a limited, scheduled bases on the **FIRST MONDAY of each month, beginning at 10am until we have reached our maximum capacity, at which time this form will be shut off until the next scheduled date**. Please note: unless otherwise noted directly on the form linked above, forms will be open on holidays.

Please note that once you are able to submit your information through this form and are then contacted to schedule, **PRE-PAYMENT FOR SURGERY WILL BE REQUIRED FROM ALL CLIENTS to hold any surgery spots scheduled for you**. You will be given a surgery date when we call you back to schedule. For pricing information, please see the information listed here <https://preventalitter.org/surgery-prices>. Submission of the form linked above does not guarantee an appointment. If you submit your information through the form, you will be contacted to discuss scheduling.

If your vet has diagnosed your dog with a MEDICAL CONDITION that requires spay or neuter as treatment or you have a PREGNANT dog, please call 804-359-6369 to speak with a staff member. Please do not call or email about your request for routine spay or neuter. This delays our response time for all clients.

Please complete this form ONLY for **new** routine dog spay or neuter requests. If you need to reschedule an appointment that is already paid for, please DO NOT submit this form and contact us directly via phone.

Prevent A Litter is only able to review surgery requests to be performed within the next 1-2 months. Do not submit this form at this time for any dogs that you wish to book farther out than two months. Dogs must be a minimum age of 3 months at the time of surgery.

Note: **Due to high demand, we are only able to schedule a maximum of TWO (2) dogs per family per month**. The ability to schedule two dogs per family on the same day, extra large dogs, **cryptorchid**¹ male dogs or any other non-routine spay/neuter surgical request (such as a hernia repair) is dependent on availability and will be discussed when you are called.

Note: **Prevent A Litter is unable to schedule female dogs weighing 100 pounds or more, or male dogs weighing 110 pounds or more.**

For the health and safety of your pet, medical issues found to be present on the day of a pet's surgery may necessitate rescheduling the appointment. Rescheduling fees may apply. It is essential that any medical issues or concerns be disclosed at the the time of scheduling, or as soon as they are noticed ahead of the appointment. Prevent A Litter reserves the right to postpone surgery at the veterinarian's discretion.

1) A dog who is **cryptorchid** has one testicle that has not descended (dropped). A dog who is bilaterally cryptorchid has both testicles that have not descended. Please be sure to disclose on the form if your dog is cryptorchid so it can be discussed at the time of scheduling.

*FOR CLIENTS NEEDING TO SCHEDULE FOR ***MALE DOGS ONLY***: Occasionally, we may be able to receive requests outside of the above described schedule for MALE DOGS only. Please see below.
