Growing up I remember going to the polls with my mother and that was always very very important in my home. Well I was born in the 60s, so in the 60s so much happened with civil rights and I believe that my parents and her parents fought really hard for those rights to vote and many of our rights. My mother made it a point to show us how to live upright and then also how to respect the things that people fought for — for us. So, we always had to go and stand at the booth with mommy while she voted and our grandparent while they voted.
