WHAT IS IT?

College courses available for high school students at their local high school. Students will receive high school credit AND college credit at the same time. **ALL COURSES ARE THROUGH SALT LAKE COMMUNITY COLLEGE (SLCC) EXCEPT WHERE NOTED.**

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

APPLICATION FEE: SLCC Fee is waived through Spring 2022. Weber State Fee \$35. University of Utah Fee \$55

TUITION FEE will be charged for all Concurrent Enrollment classes. **\$5 per credit hour.**

STEP 1: Complete **Course request in the Course Selection.**

STEP 2: Complete **SLCC college application** between **NOW through August 2022** slcc.edu/concurrentenrollment

STEP 3: **MATH and ENGLISH** students SIGN UP NOW for SLCC Placement to qualify. Once you sign up, we will send you more information.

When signing up for ACT or AP, request scores to be sent to SLCC.

Concurrent Enrollment

Steps for SLCC Admission & Registration

Students must be admitted to Salt Lake Community College in order to take concurrent enrollment classes. If students have **never** taken concurrent classes at Salt Lake Community College the following steps must be taken to complete the on-line application and pay the **one-time \$40.00 application fee**. Fee is waived for Spring 2022. This should be done as soon as possible. *Students who have previously taken concurrent classes must provide their SLCC S# to the Career Center or CE instructor but will not need to re-apply.*
Please note: There is a \$5.00 per credit fee that will be assessed by SLCC at the time of registration for courses.

To apply, you will need:

1. **School State ID (SSID)** This is found in Discovery under 'Student Information' on the Student's account only, not parents. It is a 7 digit number) - This is NOT your student ID Number
2. ~~Debit/Credit Card to pay the \$40 Admission Fee.~~ Fee is waived through Spring 2022.

STEP 1: Apply for SLCC Admission. Go to www.slcc.edu/concurrentenrollment.

STEP 2: Wait for a reply letter. The SLCC student number, called your "S" number, will arrive in the mail a week after you complete the application. Record your number where you won't lose it and can access it quickly (e.g. your mobile device, etc.). You may also ask your teacher or Career Center if they can see your S number on MYCE 48 hours after applying.

STEP 3: Parent Permission Form VERY IMPORTANT step! Go to https://ushece.service-now.com/concurrent_enrollment. In order to avoid paying twice, please make sure you apply to SLCC first.

STEP 4: Set up MySLCC account. (This is your college account, similar to your high school Skyward Account) Go to www.slcc.edu/concurrentenrollment. Click **MySLCC** at the top of the page and click '**MySLCC**'. Click on "Retrieve your student name and user name". Complete the information.
Your username and S# will appear on the screen. Take a picture or write it down before you exit!

STEP 5: – Register for CE classes online before the deadline. You will obtain the class CRN number (course #) from your teacher the first week of class. Follow instructions under 'Registration' on www.slcc.edu/concurrentenrollment

STEP 6: – Pay Tuition Fee. The \$5.00 per credit hour tuition may be paid at the time of registration. You can pay tuition online, by phone at 801-957-4868, or in person at a Cashier's Window at SLCC. Visit www.slcc.edu/concurrentenrollment for instructions.
