In this assessment, you are to show evidence of having carried out adequate and relevant research for the Research Argument Essay in the Writing component for EAP 1B. Also you must show that you have critically evaluated each source, and identify suitable sections of it for inclusion in your essay.

- You will be given a *Research Essay Readings* booklet for your chosen topic.
- You must review **3 sources**-

- **2** sources from the provided readings
- **1** source from your own research

- Choose 2 of the sources to review from the provided readings booklet.
- You will have to choose the 3rd source to review by conducting your own research.
- Your 3rd source must be an appropriate academic source, which means choosing one of:
 - a journal article, or the abstract of a journal article if you are unable to access the article
 - a textbook, monograph or article from an edited collection
 - an official report

You will need to use *Google*, *Google Books* and *Google Scholar* to find this source, as well as for further research for your essay. You can also use your State Library Card to look for e-resources.

- You must provide full reference details for each source using APA Referencing Style. Refer to *Your Guide to APA 6th Style Referencing* (University of Sydney 2013).
- You must provide an in-text reference for both the quote and the paraphrased/summarised quote
- You must include both integral and non-integral references in your research review
- You should indicate what quotes or information you intend to use in your essay, choose at least two quotes for each text and summarise/paraphrase them, with some comments about how they are relevant to your essay/essay plan.
