CFES Health and Safety Guidelines for Face to Face Students

- All students and staff are required to screen daily prior to reporting to school (or entering a school bus) **Student Daily Health Screening Document** will be sent by TISD.
- All students are required to wear masks daily on campus when not socially distanced and in all common areas (entering school, hallways, etc.)
- Student lockers for 4th and 5th Grade will not be used this year.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottle. Thanks to our generous community, water bottle filling stations were installed in 2019-2020 in various locations around the building.
- Visitors will not be permitted on campus through December 2020. The district will reevaluate visitors on campus closer to the second semester.
- Parent meetings will be held virtually when possible.
- This year at CFES we will continue to celebrate student birthdays during Call to Greatness. Unfortunately birthday treats may not be brought in.
- Please help your child arrive on campus with everything that they need for the day as we can't allow drop off for student items (forgotten lunches, folders etc.)
- Additional cleaning and sanitation supplies will be provided to all teachers and staff.
- Specific guidelines for our nurse's response to students that become ill while at school will be sent through TISD communications. Parents please be mindful that should your child become ill while on campus, it would be important to have someone close designated to come in a timely manner.
