- Carlstrom's group (Tom Crawford) has equipment in Accelerator who's contents need to be transferred to Hinds onto new hardware - i.e. the "legacy" SPT servers
- One of these servers has arrived and is installed; the second has a two week time frame - tbc.
- Email lists
 - From Abby sounds like this is now in Elena's hands?
 - Tom reports we have an inventory of lists and aliases. Two mailman servers - box and oddjob. In addition a large number of aliases on kicp, which are being effectively used as distribution lists. See the text file.
- Email server retirement
 - Restarting the process for A&A servers
 - We have previously done this for theory. Math and Stats was the larger effort. They moved content to several services. This was wrapped up late summer last year.
 - Some users will be difficult
 - Carlstrom, York, Don Lamb (Carolyn met yesterday)
 - Bittitan tool was used in the past - to login to imap server as user, connect to whichever destination.
 - Delegate MX only? Been migrating to letsEncrypt
 - Help needed from ITS - yes.

 - This will be a huge undertaking - will be disruptive to users.
 - Should we wait on this? Probably for now.
 - Need to get inventory of email servers.
 - There was a directory server across machines? Probably not, but UIDs seem to be consistent with Valerie's LDAP. (At least two)

 - N.B. Hull accounts, but cVPN.
 - Also - could use a bastion host.

Needed SPT Support (Tom Crawford)

SPT folks have put together this list. The machines in question are primarily the “number-crunchers” spt.uchicago.edu, sptcloud.uchicago.edu, sptoir.uchicago.edu, and

sza.uchicago.edu, but Valeri also maintained some public webpages and wiki servers for the collaboration.

Task	How to cover?
Root stuff like user accounts	Tom Crawford has sudo
Hard reboots	Judith? (TC can do if someone shows him.) PSD Computing has access to HindsDC. Can we set up virtual console or similar? Dell DRAC?
Failed Hardware, need physical access - e.g., if a disk accidentally fills up, it might malfunction, disks don't auto remount after reboot	
License Servers maintenance (IDL, HFSS, Solidworks)	This is actually a KICP/A&A-wide issue, not specific to SPT (or SPT legacy). Someone from PSD computing (Tom I.?) to operate until Valeri replacement is hired. What about backup? Effective backup of pole wikis at Pole, but more generally we don't know.
Wiki Support (air.uchicago.edu - clusters; sptpol; spt3g)	Need help from someone who has access to flame.uchicago.edu (the physical machine that hosts pole).
SPT public website (pole.uchicago.edu)	Brad B. has direct pole access and is mostly maintaining the website. When others need to contribute, BB or TC can open a temporary ssh tunnel.
Automatic backups of user directories	The only auto backups have been of /dataX/home. TC has been manually backing up other spt and sptcloud /data directories and will continue (and possibly adding sptoir).
SPT CVS/SVN repos; mysql database; SPTOIR condor	Sudo privilege + systems knowledge / googling. Could use some preventative investigation of what tools are installed.

- Tom Indelli notes administrative access needs to be given - where can we get it?
- Question about what to do with ~ 1 PB of legacy data. Tom will re-assess and identify what needs to be saved. Post this, we'll size up what replacement equipment would look like rather than relocate.
- Hard reboots. Judith can be point, Steve can be the Second.
- Indelli: can setup monitoring

Job Description: Valeri Galtsev, Senior System Administrator

Maintain the KICP and Astronomy Computing Infrastructure.

Work with the administration to purchase suitable computational hardware and software for the KICP and Astronomy.

Maintain both hardware and software in optimal condition; upgrade/patch/replace items as needed and as allowed by budgetary constraints.

Install, configure, upgrade, maintain, monitor and tune performance for Windows, Macintosh, Linux, and UNIX operating systems, utility software and server hardware including installation of patches and services.

Work with individual KICP and Astronomy investigators to create and maintain suitable computing environments/clusters to support the individual projects.

Work with individual investigators to purchase computers and software for day-to-day use (e.g., laptops).

Install and maintain signage server and peripheral equipment (signage screens).

Investigate and purchase appropriate site Licenses for KICP and Astronomy use.

Work with UChicago ITServices to maintain optimal network performance.

Maintain security and access control on KICP and Astronomy electronic intellectual property.

Provide individual computer support as necessary.

Maintain KICP and Astronomy printing environment, ensuring members the ability to print as required.

Provide other IT support for KICP and Astronomy as necessary (ceiling projectors, meeting rooms etc)
