Employment History/Experience:

- **Hospital Training:-** Jan '02- Jan '03 – Southern Health Care Network, Melbourne Australia. First Year Hospital Medical Officer (Intern). Between May '03 and Jul '05 – locum posts in various hospitals throughout the UK in a variety of specialties, including A&E, general medicine and general surgery.
- **GP Training:-** From Aug '05 to Jul '08 – completed the General Practice VTS program at the Lister Hospital, Stevenage, and at Larksfield Surgery, Bedfordshire. This included passing my MRCGP assessments.
- **Full Time GP Partner:-** Full Time Partner at Cranwich Road Surgery, from Aug 2008 to present, in an NHS GMS Practice (8700 patients) in Stamford Hill, Hackney, North London. I have particular experience with children, as 50% of our patients are aged under 18 yrs.

- **Out of Hours NHS GP:-** I have undertaken sessional work for Herts Urgent Care, BarnDoc and CHUHSE (the Barnet and City and Hackney NHS OOH cooperative, respectively) on a regular basis from 2008 to 2019. This involved primarily telephone triage, as well as seeing face to face patients in clinic, as well as home visiting.
- **Private GP:-** I have worked for 2 private GP services in North London – JDOC and Myers Medical Group, between 2013-2015 (involving both clinic and home consultations). In Dec 2019 I started working regularly for ZoomDoc, providing private in hours and out of hours GP visiting to homes of patients, as well as telephone consultations. I ceased working for ZoomDoc in Sept '21. I continue to see private patients on an ad hoc basis who contact me directly, and have been doing so for over 10 years.
- **Medico-legal expert witness:-** Since 2010 I have undertaken report writing for personal injury cases, as well as clinical negligence cases since 2013. Since 2018 I have been writing reports for cases presented to the General Medical Council and have presented oral evidence to the MPTS on 6 occasions. I am registered with MedCo to provide reports in RTA claims. On average I provide 50 Personal Injury reports per year (all direct instructions from Claimant Solicitors), and 50 reports for Clinical Negligence and Fitness to Practise (40/60 Claimant/Defendant ratio). I have experience in preparation of multiple joint statements.
- **GP Commissioning:-** From Apr '18 until Mar '21, I was the Chair of the North West Hackney Consortium of the City and Hackney CCG. This role involved chairing meetings of the local GPs, arranging and reviewing audits of practices across the north of Hackney and attending the Clinical Executive Meetings of the CCG. Following this (in Apr '21) I became the Primary Care Quality and Safety lead for two local Primary Care Networks (PCNs), which involves dealing with issues of patient safety within the wider NHS structure, and ensuring compliance with local Enhanced Services designed to deliver higher quality primary care for patients. At present this is under the auspices of the North East London Integrated Care System (NELICS). This role ceased on 31 Dec '22.
- **Medical Director of two volunteer ambulance services:-** Hatzola North London and Hatzola Canvey Island. These roles involve being in charge of clinical governance and signing off all operational policies. Both since Dec '21
- **Medico-Legal Courses undertaken:-** I undertook the course entitled 'Expert Witness Training for Medical Professionals,' which was run by Inspire MediLaw, in Sept '19. This course is accredited for CPD by the Royal Society of Medicine, and covered the following areas:-

I comply with the Civil Procedure Rules 1998 (revised Oct 2009) and have undergone training in the principles of the Test cases of Bolam (Eng and Wal) modified by Bolitho, Bailey (Eng), and Montgomery.
