For now I only do PONY AND FURRY HEADSHOTS.

The price depends on:

- the type of canvas you choose,
- canvas size,
- character design complexity,
- background complexity,
- number of addons.

All of those will be explained later in this document 😊

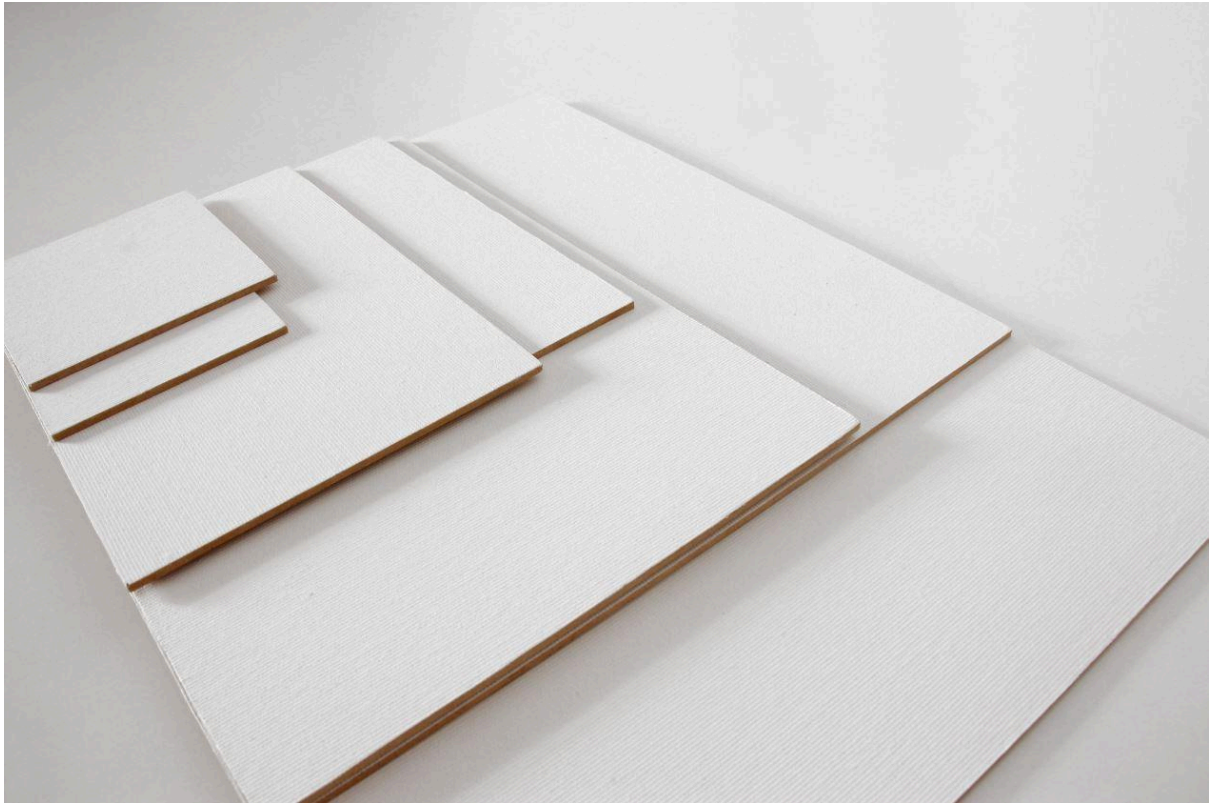
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1. Available canvas types and sizes.

1.1 Flat canvas.



Sizes and shapes available right away:

Rectangular (in cm):

- 9x13,
- 10x10,
- 13x18,
- 15x15,
- 15x21,
- 18x24,
- 20x20,
- 25x25.

Oval (in cm):

- 18x24.

Round (in cm):

- 20.

1.2 Regular canvas.



Sizes available right away (in cm):

- 13x18,
- 15x15,
- 15x20,
- 15x21,
- 18x24,
- 20x25.

If you'd like another size or shape feel free to ask and I will check if your request is possible.
The sizes and shapes listed are available right away and [priced later on in this document.](#)

2. Colors and paint types.

I mostly use acrylic paint, but generally I go with mixed media (markers, crayons etc.).

Therefore, the paintings I make are **NOT WATERPROOF**.

I am going to do my best to secure the painting (I'm going to expand on that in the "shipping" section of this document) so you receive it in perfect condition, but afterwards please make sure it doesn't have contact with water as this might significantly damage it.

As this is a traditional art form the final colors of your characters might differ from the digital version of the reference you provided me, although I am going to do my best to recreate the colors perfectly.

The fee for the materials covers any new paint I have to purchase in order to finish your art piece, so don't worry about any extra fees for wild colors. Although additional fees can apply if your character design includes a wide variety of different colors and shades as usually designs like this require more work and attention to details. This matter will be personally discussed with you.

Aside from the regular acrylic paint I use you can also ask for:

- pearl acrylic paint (white, red, blue, green),
- metallic acrylic paint (copper, gold and silver),
- fluorescent acrylic paint (yellow, orange, pink, green).

3. Backgrounds.

I prefer abstract backgrounds, but I can also do a specific outdoor and indoors scenery. Keep in mind with the complexity of the background the prices can change.

Background types I can do:

- flat color,
- patterns,
- rooms,
- outdoor scenery.

4. Shipping.

To make sure your painting gets to you safely the only option for shipping a painting is Global Express. From experience it's the safest and fastest available way for me to send out packages. The usual waiting time from the moment the parcel is dropped off at the post office is 1-2 weeks depending on its destination. This shipment method also includes a tracking number. Below I simplified the shipping pricing, but depending on the specific destination the prices can change a little bit. You will be given a final price once I know the exact destination the package should be shipped to.

Simplified pricing (in USD):

USA:

- economy: 16,
- priority: 23.

Australia:

- economy: 17,
- priority: 30.

Europe:

- economy: 13-16,
- priority: 10-20.

South America and Asia:

- economy: 17,
- priority: 23.

5. Addons.

Addons are additional elements I can add to the canvas.

Examples:

- fake gems,
- beads,
- ribbons etc.

Those are fully customizable according to your wishes.

I will try my best to figure out your request, but please keep in mind my abilities are limited.

Of course if I feel like I won't be able to fulfill your wish you will be informed right away.

6. Base pricing.

The prices below include manual labor and basic materials costs (flat canvas, regular acrylic paints, packaging and protection) and flat color background.

7. The process

1. I received a message from you.

What should you include?

Just the information that you're interested in a commission is enough.

Please note that I don't reply to just "Hi" messages.

2. We discuss the details for your commission.

You can prepare some of the details in advance, although it's perfectly fine if you're unsure or haven't commissioned anyone before and don't know how to go about it. I will try my best to take the lead, explain everything, answer any of your questions and make the process as easy for you as possible.

Examples of the things you can prepare in advance:

- Canvas size and/or shape,
- Character reference (can be any artwork(s) with the character you want to get painted),
- Description of the pose and/or facial expression,
- Your idea for the background (color, kind of pattern, kind of scenery),
- List of additional requests you have,
- List of important things you'd like me to keep in mind (for example character's features that are easily overlooked),
- Country of destination.

3. I give you an estimated quote for your painting.
4. I make a sketch and deliver it to you so you can check it and let me know if anything needs to be fixed or changed.

Please take note the sketch provided won't be shipped to you, as it's prepared in my personal sketchbook.

5. Once the sketch is finished I will send you the invoice and continue working after the payment is completed.
6. I transfer the sketch to the canvas. Once I'm done you're going to receive a WIP to check if everything is correct.
7. I get to painting.

This step can take anywhere from one to a few days (depending mostly on the size of canvas). You most likely won't get any WIPs for painting I can finish in one day. If the painting is going to take multiple days you most likely will get a WIP for each day I've spent working on your painting.

8. Once I'm done you will receive a picture of the finished painting.

At this stage I can still fix some very minor details

9. I pack your order and drop it at the post office.

Once your package has been dropped off I will send you a tracking number for your package.

10. Wait for the package to arrive :3

Please contact me for any issues you have with your package.

I can take care of any type of official complaint to the shipping company if your parcel arrives damaged or is lost.
