The literacy calendar is a service of the State Library of Ohio in collaboration with Ohio Ready to Read, Day By Day Ohio supports early literacy skills, helps young children get ready for school, and is available 24/7.

<u>ABCmouse</u> - A popular online curriculum for ages 2-8 on subjects such as math, reading, and science.

ABCya - Offers games and mobile apps for learning numbers and letters.

<u>Cookie</u> - Dedicated toward younger learners with a focus on building skills in areas such as math, phonics, and science.

<u>Education City</u> - An online platform for grades PreK-6 featuring educational games, resources, and activities.

<u>Learning Games for Kids</u> - Features more than 20 preschool activities geared to build mouse and pre-phonics reading skills, plus foster a love of learning.

PBS Kids - Games, videos, and more, featuring popular PBS characters.

<u>Peep and the Big Wide World</u> - Designed for young science learners with games, videos, and activities teaching about sounds, animals, physics, and more.

<u>Planet Nutshell</u> - Features animated videos for students of all ages including preschool, focusing on climate science, physics, and math.

<u>Share My Lesson</u> - Offers a wide range of resources and lesson plans for educators of PreK students.

<u>Super Teacher Worksheets</u> - My favorite site for worksheets, printables, activites, and more, with an abundance of resources for preschool.

- Separate from primary caregiver without anxiety?
- Use self-control?
 - Keeping hands to self
 - Sharing and taking turns
 - Cooperating and playing with other children
 - Using classroom supplies appropriately
- Cooperate with adults and authority figures?
 - Following directions
 - Communicating needs effectively
