Meteorite is a student-run undergraduate philosophy journal affiliated with the Philosophy Department at the University of Michigan. Our mission is to promote the discussion of novel and thought-provoking philosophical ideas by providing students from diverse backgrounds with an opportunity to have their original work published in an academic journal. We are now accepting 4-6 undergraduate philosophy papers for consideration for our Spring 2027 issue.

Authors of selected papers will be invited to present their work at an undergraduate philosophy conference [virtual or in-person format TBD] hosted by the editors of *Meteorite*.

Submission Deadline: All papers must be submitted for our consideration by **January 1, 2027, at 11:59 PM**. Decisions on all submissions will be made by mid-February, and the issue will be published in April.

Submission Guidelines: Please use [this form](#) (UPDATE FORM) to submit your papers. Please ensure papers adhere to the following guidelines.

Abstract: Submissions may include an abstract of no more than 200 words - this is encouraged but not required.

Citation Style: Chicago Style citations with notes and a bibliography are preferred, but other citation styles are also acceptable. Authors may be asked to adjust the format of their citations if their paper is selected for publication.

Cover Page: Include a cover page with (1) your name, (2) email address, and (3) affiliated academic institution. Identifying information should not appear elsewhere in the paper to ensure an impartial, blind review process.

File Format: Please submit papers in a .doc, .docx, or .pdf format and title the document '[Last Name, First Name] - Meteorite 2027.'

Length: Submissions should not exceed 6000 words in length and should be double-spaced, Times New Roman 12-pt font. Shorter papers are also acceptable.

Originality: Our journal is committed to publishing original student work. Plagiarism of any kind will disqualify your paper from consideration for publication.

Topic: *Meteorite* will be accepting analytic OR continental-style philosophical papers from any discipline for the upcoming issue.

Authors of papers submitted before the deadline will receive confirmation of submission from the staff at *Meteorite*. We accept multiple submissions from each author, as long as each submission is the author's original work and is substantially different from other submissions. Submitting a paper to other journals for consideration is also allowed, but please keep us informed of its publication status.
