## How do I create an account and log in to Edulastic?

All teachers in Gr 5-12 have free premium accounts for Edulastic through the remainder of the year.

- You and your students should log into Edulastic through Classlink.
- Before having your students log in, create a class and then get a code that your students will use to enroll in your class. Edulastic is not auto rostered.
- You can also create a class by syncing your Google classroom to Edulastic
