

Each year at the athletic banquet, our athletes are recognized for their hard work and commitment to their teams. Each intramural sports team will nominate one **Most Valued Played (MVP)** and **Most Dedicated Player (MDP)**. In addition to these titles, athletes can be nominated for the following awards:

Team Representative Awards

The William Crichton Webster's Award (Women's): This award, donated by the 2008-09 Executive for annual presentation, will be awarded to the female team representative who has demonstrated leadership, dedication, and enthusiasm to the intramural program. This person has served in an outstanding capacity as an ambassador of the intramural program by committing a significant amount of time to their team and its members. They will have an extensive knowledge of the sport and a natural ability to unite others to a

The William Crichton Webster's Award (Men's): This award, donated by the 2008-09 Executive for annual presentation, will be awarded to the male team representative who has demonstrated leadership, dedication, and enthusiasm to the intramural program. This person has served in an outstanding capacity as an ambassador of the intramural program by committing a significant amount of time to their team and its members. They will have an extensive knowledge of the sport and a natural ability to unite others to a common purpose.

The William Crichton Webster's Award (Coed): This award, donated by the 2008-09 Executive for annual presentation, will be awarded to the co-ed team representative who has demonstrated leadership, dedication, and enthusiasm to the intramural program. This person has served in an outstanding capacity as an ambassador of the intramural program by committing a significant amount of time to their team and its members. They will have an extensive knowledge of the sport and a natural ability to unite others to a common purpose.

Athletic Sticks

The Women's Athletic Stick: The Women's Athletic Stick shall be given as the highest honour in women's athletics to an athlete who, in their graduating year, has met most satisfactorily the conditions under which the award is made. These conditions are holding of the Fourth Colour; exhibition of leadership (as a member or team representative of a team or as a member of the V.C.A.A.); and displaying sportsmanship. This award will be voted on at the Athletic Banquet.

The Men's Athletic Stick: The Men's Athletic Stick shall be given as the greatest honour in men's athletics to an athlete who, in his graduating year, has met most satisfactorily the conditions under which the award is made. These conditions are holding of the Fourth Colour; exhibition of leadership (as a member or team representative of a team or as a member of the V.C.A.A.); and displaying sportsmanship. This award will be voted on at the Athletic Banquet.

First Year Awards

The First Year Award: This award (2 available), donated by the 1979 Executive for annual presentation, will be awarded for sportsmanship to the players who have demonstrated outstanding sportsmanship in their participation in the athletic program at the varsity or intramural level in their first year at Victoria College.

Leadership Awards

The Executive Award: This award is awarded to a member of the V.C.A.A. who has shown leadership, enthusiasm, organizational skills, etc. in an outstanding capacity.

The Jen Krol Award: This award, donated by the 2006-07 Executive for annual presentation, is presented each year to the person who has demonstrated outstanding dedication to Victoria Athletics through leadership in encouraging fellow athletes and in supporting the Victoria Intramural Organization.

Contribution Awards

The Alumni Award: This award is presented to the athlete at Victoria College who is deemed to have made the greatest contribution in one year to Victoria College Athletics.

The Millennium Memorial Award: donated by the 2000 executive, will be awarded to the athlete who has made the greatest impact in a given year to Victoria student life through athletic participation, organization, and to the student community as a whole. This award is for athletes who are not a member of the V.C.A.A.

Skill Awards

The VCAU Award: This is to be presented to the athlete who has demonstrated the most skill and value to the men's team(s) on which they have played. The award shall be given primarily on the basis of performance on the field of play.

The Professor Grant Trophy: This is to be presented to the athlete who has demonstrated the most skill and value to the women's team(s) on which they have played. The award shall be given primarily on the basis of performance on the field of play.

The Philip Habib Award: This is to be presented to the athlete who has demonstrated the most skill and value to the coed team(s) on which they have played. The award shall be given primarily on the basis of performance on the field of play.

Commuter Awards

The Commuter Award: This award (2 available), donated by the 1988-89 Executive for annual presentation, will be awarded to the athletes who, as commuters, have demonstrated outstanding sportsmanship and participation in the intramural or intercollegiate programs in any year at Victoria College.

Sportsmanship Awards

The Sarah Russell Memorial Award: This award will be given to the player in their third academic year who had exhibited qualities of sportsmanship and enthusiasm on women's teams that marked the late Sarah Russell's intramural participation.

The Stan Lane Trophy: This award will be given to the player in their third academic year who had exhibited qualities of sportsmanship and enthusiasm on men's teams.

The Pam Chapman Award: This award will be given to the player in their third academic year who had exhibited qualities of sportsmanship and enthusiasm on coed teams.

Victoria College Colours

First Colour

It shall be awarded upon the accumulation of a minimum of 25 points.

Second Colour

The recipient must hold the equivalent of a first colour. The recipient must have accumulated a minimum of 50 points.

Third Colour

The recipient must hold the equivalent of first and second colours. The recipient must have accumulated a minimum of 75 points.

Fourth Colour

The recipient must hold the equivalent of first, second, and third colours. The recipient must have accumulated a minimum of 100 points.

Points are awarded as follows:

- Full year sport = 10 points
- Half year sport = 5 points
- Tournament participant = 3 points
- Team representative = 3 points
- Intramural champion = 2 points

- Intramural finalists = 1 point
- Varsity team = 16 points
- Tri-Campus = 12 points
- V.C.A.A. member = 16 points

Only players that are playoff eligible (played in approximately half of the regular season games) will receive points. Members of the V.C.A.A. must also meet their attendance requirement to be awarded their 16 points.
