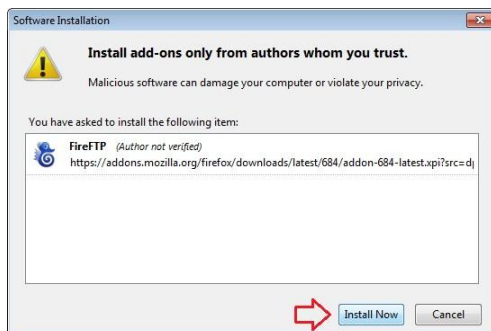
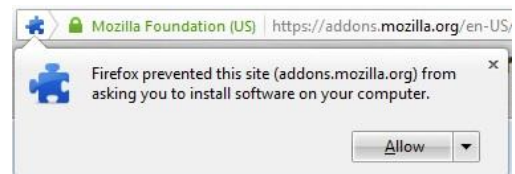

Installation

To install FireFTP, click **Add to Firefox** on the [FireFTP Download Page](#),

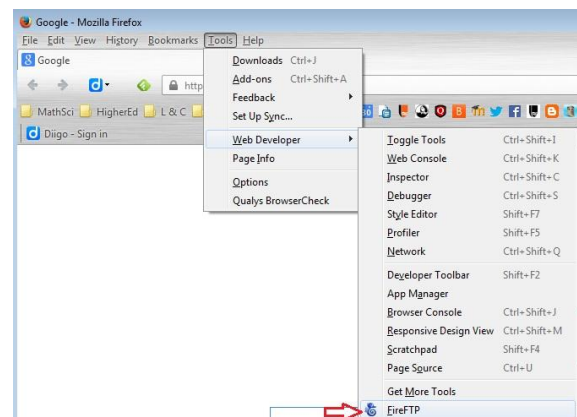


You'll may be prompted to Allow the installation to continue. Click **Allow**.



FireFTP will download. Click **Install Now** to begin the installation. Restart FireFox if prompted to do so.

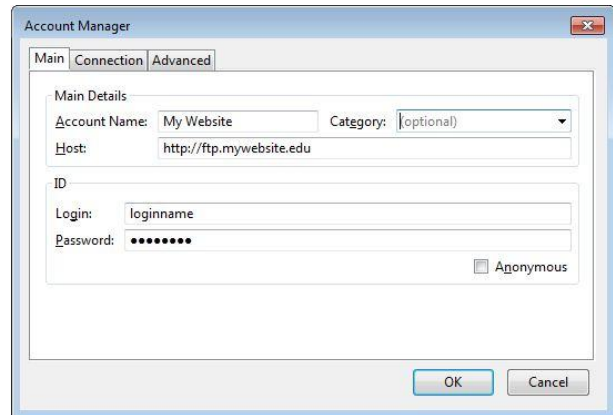
To open FireFTP, from the FireFox menu bar, select **Tools > Web Developer > FireFTP**.



FireFTP opens in a FireFox browser tab, so you can drag FireFTP to the bookmarks bar and launch it from there. If the bookmarks toolbar is not visible, select **View > Toolbars > Bookmarks Toolbar**.

Connect to an FTP Server

1. Under the accounts menu in the top left, select **"Create an account..."**
Enter in the name of the server you wish to connect in the **"Host"** field.
2. Enter your login and password in the appropriate fields
3. Click **Ok** to save the account information and to close the dialog. The FTP profile will remain saved the accounts menu.
4. Click the **"Connect"** button to make the connection to your site.



Once you've connected, local files appear on the left and the remote files on the right. To upload a file to the server, click on a local file and press the arrow pointing to the right. Similarly, download a file from the server to your computer by clicking a file on the right side and pressing the arrow pointing to the left.
