The One Anothers

The LORD is clear in His Word and repeats Himself often in His commands, a desire for believers to be devoted to one another continually. The following list of verses is intended to encourage believers in their pursuit of loving one another as Christ has loved us.

★ Love one another

- o John 13:34-35- A new commandment I give to you, that you <u>love one another</u>: just as I have loved you, you also are to <u>love one another</u>. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.
- o John 15:12- This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.
- o 1 John 3:11- For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should <u>love</u> one another
- o Romans 12:10- Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.

★ Be at peace with one another

• Mark 9:50- Salt is good, but if the salt has lost its saltiness, how will you make it salty again? *Have salt in yourselves, and be at peace with one another.

★ Serve one another

- Galatians 5:13- For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love <u>serve one another</u>.
- 1 Peter 4:10- As each has received a gift, use it to <u>serve one another</u>, as good stewards of God's varied grace:

★ Submit to and show humility to one another

- Ephesians 5:21- <u>submitting to one another</u> out of reverence for Christ.
- 1 Peter 5:5- Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with <u>humility toward one another</u>, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

★ Bear with and forgive one another

• Colossians 3:13- <u>bearing with one another</u> and, if one has a complaint against another, <u>forgiving each other</u>; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

★ Teach and admonish one another

 Colossians 3:16- Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, <u>teaching and admonishing one</u> <u>another</u> in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

★ Encourage one another

- 1 Thessalonians 5:11- Therefore <u>encourage one another</u> and build one another up, just as you are doing.
- Hebrews 10:24-25- And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but <u>encouraging one another</u>, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

★ Confess sin to one another

• James 5:16- Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

★ Do not pass judgment, provoke, envy, lie to, or grumble against one another

- o Romans 14:13- Therefore <u>let us not pass judgment on one another</u> any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.
- Galatians 5:26- Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.
- Colossians 3:9- <u>Do not lie to one another</u>, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices
- James 5:9- <u>Do not grumble against one another</u>, brothers, so that you may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing at the door.
