

IFLTA Creative Projects Contest Information

The IFLTA Creative Projects Contest is an opportunity for World Language educators from across the 'Hoosier State' to showcase the creativity of their students and of the activities and lessons that they teach/explore in their classrooms. The IFLTA Annual Conference showcases the creativity of teachers, but we all know our students display incredible creativity each day in our classrooms!

World Language teachers attending the 2025 IFLTA Annual Conference are invited to submit a **MAXIMUM of three (3) entries** of creative projects from their students to be displayed at the conference and to be considered for recognition. Creative projects can be two-dimensional or three-dimensional and should reflect your course.

Certificates for 1st and 2nd place for each division (elementary, middle school/junior high, and high school) will be awarded. A cash prize will be awarded to the overall winner of all divisions.

- Teachers submitting projects are asked to provide a typed description of the student project with a length of no more than 400 words to be included with the project title and information below. This description should explain the project and how it connects to the teacher's course.
- Teachers submitting projects are asked to bring their projects to the Creative Projects Contest display tables located in the (LOCATION- lobby/hall) between Thursday, 11/06, at 5 PM to Friday, 11/07 at 7 AM. They will be asked to display the project along with the typed description and student information.
- Voting on the best projects will be on Friday, 11/07. Results will be announced at the luncheon on Saturday, and teachers of awarded students will be recognized.
