The purpose of the home-parent compact is to establish on-going communication between the home and school.

As a Rockport-Fulton High School student, I have the ultimate responsibility of learning. Therefore, I pledge to:

9. Monitor my grades and attendance through Skyward.

11. Utilize my school-issued device daily and comply with the restriction on the use of personal communication devices on campus.

4. Encourage my child to follow the policies of the school's disciplinary handbook.
5. Instill acceptable social morals and values in my child.

9. Monitor my child's grades, behavior, and attendance through Skyward and follow up if needed.
