Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Your child's safety is my number one concern! Plan on walking your child to me by the cones in front of the driveway. **DO NOT park across the street** so children are not tempted to cross the street. **Please do not pull into the driveway.** I will be standing by the cones with our class rope. Students will grab a handle on the class rope and stay with me. After everyone arrives, we will head down the east side of my home and go straight in the preschool entrance behind the garage. At the end of our day, I will help them put on coats and backpacks and we will walk out together for pick-up. Please come to the class rope and take your child by the hand, so I know they are safe! Students will only be sent home with the adult listed on their registration card unless prior arrangements are made.

Attic Schoolhouse Binders

Each student will receive a binder filled with activities to help them continue their learning at home. Please take time to use the supplies in the binders. If you choose one activity a day, I promise your student will not only gain ability and confidence but will be better prepared to enter Kindergarten. Each student will take a kindergarten standard assessment in the months of September, January, and May. I use the assessment to help individualize activities we do as a class and to know what skills each child needs to practice with Grandma Sue. I am excited to work together with you, we are a team!

Preschool Instagram

Most class days I will post a little message that offers hints about what we learned in school that day. Hopefully, the message will stimulate conversation and help reinforce the concepts learned. Please go over artwork and papers together with your child. Ask what stories were shared and ask them to retell them. Ask them to share their favorite part of the day. Remember, a child's play is their work! I will also use this to send reminders of parties, field trips, etc.

Tuition

Because each month has a different number of classes, tuition is divided into ten equal payments due August - May. **The Red Class, held Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00-11:30 a.m., is \$205 a month.** **The Blue Class, held Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 9:00-11:30 am, is \$170 a month.** **The Green Class, held Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 12:00-2:30 pm, is \$170 a month.** The Red Class will have approximately 95 preschool days throughout the year. The Blue Class will have approximately 65 preschool days throughout the year. The Green Class will have approximately 65 preschool days throughout the year. As a precaution, I have added extra days of preschool to the calendar. I do this in case I am unable to hold preschool at any time during the year due to a family emergency, illness, etc. If I can attend all preschool dates as listed on the website, including the extra days, there will be no additional charge, that will be my gift to you! Snack Box

The Snack Box goes home every 6 weeks for the Blue Class and Green class, and once a month for the Red Class. Please send a snack that is store-bought. Show and Tell

Students take turns bringing home the Show and Tell bag. Help your child fill the bag with one item they would like to show the class. (Please no weapon-like toys, small pieces, or fragile items.) Help them prepare 2-3 clues, so the class can guess what the item is; for example: color, shape, purpose, heavy or light, soft or rough.

Mascot

Preschoolers take turns with our Class Mascots, which will be POCKET PALS this year! When it is their turn to have a sleepover with a pocket pal – they will pick a pocket pal stuffed animal to take home and KEEP. When they return to class, they can share with us what they did together!
