Purpose: The students will learn how to search the internet for pictures, save them to their home drive. The students will also show their mastery of Photoshop by adding a picture of themselves to the internet pictures. The students will show their mastery of a digital camera by taking pictures of themselves to add to the pictures off the internet. Students will turn in 7-4" x 6" jpg files, 300 resolution, original digital prints.

Assignment: The student will search the internet and find 7 pictures of famous places they would like to visit. *(Make sure to get the highest resolution picture possible.)* Save the internet pictures in their home drive. The student will then shoot pictures of themselves [remember lighting angle] to place in the pictures using Photoshop, as if they had visited the place. Add text [captions] where warranted. The student will turn in 7-4" x 6" jpg files, 300 res, original prints, one for each of the 7 places they would like to visit.
