



CMMUN Delegate Dress Code – Mar 6, 2025

Appropriate attire for MUN is international business attire with the exception of “National Dress” being allowed.

The following guidelines indicate what is acceptable:

Girls:

Dresses – to the knee or lower, with sleeves so shoulders are covered

Skirts – to the knee or lower

Slacks – full-length, tailored trousers; may be khakis, no jeans/denim, no cargo pants or Capri pants

Shirts – collared dress shirt with sleeves so shoulders are covered, short sleeves OK

Tie – optional

Jackets or sweaters – optional (but may be needed due to A/C)

- Sweaters: cardigan style preferred; no hoodies/sweatshirts

- No bright colors, bold patterns, or logos permitted; school jackets are OK

Boys:

Slacks – full-length, tailored trousers; may be khakis, no jeans/denim, no cargo pants

Shirts – collared business shirt- long sleeves preferred, short sleeves OK

- It is recommended that boys wear an undershirt under their dress shirt

Tie – regular or bow tie required

Jacket/suit coat – optional (but may be needed due to A/C)

- Sweaters: cardigan style preferred; no hoodies/sweatshirts

- No bright colors, bold patterns, or logos permitted; school jackets are OK

Shoes:

Dress shoes – heels, dress shoes, mono-colored sneakers, or shoes of a national outfit

- No sandals or open-toed shoes
