Project Linus is a community of volunteers whose mission is to provide new, handmade blankets to children suffering from serious illness, trauma, or otherwise in need. Items donated to Project Linus will be used to make handmade blankets for children. We adhere to the following standards for all donations:

- **ALL** donations of blankets, fabric, and yarn must be clean, in good condition, free of debris, and without musty or noxious odors.
- **We accept** new, clean, machine washable, and dryable fabrics -- cotton, flannel, fleece, and minky -- and various cotton or acrylic yarns.
- **We accept** thread for sewing machines and cotton crochet thread for tying together quilt layers such as sandwich quilts.
- **We accept** batting.
- **We accept** sewing machines that may be used by our volunteers or raffled to purchase supplies for making blankets.
- **We do not accept** outdoor, heavy cotton, wool, or fashion fabrics; drapes; or shower curtains.
- **We do not accept** old, poorly kept, smell-ridden, dirty, and / or previously used blankets or material. Blankets, material, and yarn deteriorate over time especially if stored in non-temperate conditions (e.g., attics, basements, and garages).
