


Figure 1. Information Figure

Writing a list of references according to the rules of APA Style 6 th edition. All citations to the contents of the research must be in the reference list. The reference list is sorted alphabetically. Sources of the reference list must be at least 6 references and 80% from primary sources scientific articles and the remaining 20% from other sources. (Times New Roman, size 0, before 0 pt; after 0 pt; Line spacing: 1)
