

Author Guidelines

Scope

The conference calls for original quantitative research in economics and related fields, including but not limited to development economics, macroeconomics, international economics, finance, banking, public economics, environmental and energy economics, labor economics, regional economics, agricultural economics, health economics, tourism, and industrial economics.

Manuscript Requirements

- Manuscripts must be written in **clear, professional English**.
- Submissions must be **original**, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere.
- The maximum manuscript length is **8,000 words, including tables and references**.
- Authors are encouraged to use the official manuscript template.

Manuscript Structure

Manuscripts should include the following sections:

1. Title

- Concise and informative.
- Maximum **12 words**.

2. Authors and Affiliations

- Full names, institutional affiliations, and email addresses.
- Do not include academic titles.

3. Abstract

- Maximum **300 words**.
- Should clearly state the objective, methodology, main findings, originality, and policy or practical implications.
- Do not include references.

4. Keywords

- 3–5 keywords.

5. JEL Classification

- Include 1–3 JEL classification codes.

6. Introduction

- Background, research gap, novelty, and objectives.

7. Literature Review

- Theoretical framework and review of relevant studies.

8. Data and Methods

- Data sources, variables, and empirical methodology.

9. Results and Discussion

- Present findings clearly using tables and figures where appropriate.
- Interpret results in relation to previous literature and discuss their theoretical and policy implications.

10. Conclusion

- Summarize the main findings and provide policy implications and future research directions where appropriate.

11. References

Formatting

- Microsoft Word format.
- Single-spaced.
- 12-point font.
- Tables and figures should be embedded within the text close to their first citation.
- Number all tables and figures consecutively.

References

- Follow **APA 7th Edition**.
- Suggested to use a reference manager such as **Mendeley** or **Zotero**.
- Include **at least 15 references**, with a minimum of **80% from primary scholarly sources**, preferably peer-reviewed journal articles.

- References should generally be published within the last **10 years**, except for seminal works.
- Include **DOIs** whenever available.

Review Process

All submissions undergo:

1. Initial editorial screening for scope, quality, formatting, originality, and language.
2. Double-blind peer review by at least two independent reviewers.
3. Final editorial decision based on reviewers' recommendations.
