4. Background:

As groups of people are starting to travel again after the pandemic, they'll encounter new challenges and tools that can complicate the planning process. We want to understand the challenges they face specifically during the planning phase of traveling in a group. Our team wants to address the inefficiencies of planning a vacation in a group chat and create an app where all of the information can be gathered and referenced easily. Our intent is to create a solution to address those communication issues and provide a pleasant group travel planning experience.

5. Goals:

Our goal in conducting this research is to assess the process of how people make plans when traveling in a group, and discover their biggest challenges to create a solution for better coordination and communication among the group.

6. Research questions:

1. What travel information needs to be prioritized on the platform?
2. What integrations would be advantageous to users?
3. What elements do we need to better help planners disseminate information to their travel companions?
4. What types of plans do users want to organize before the trip?
5. What frustrations do planners have when trying to confirm plans with their travel companions?
6. What information do non-planners need to reference?
7. How can we differentiate tentative plans and definitive plans in a trip schedule?
8. What accessibility features would improve users' experiences?
9. How can this product be useful during the trip or after the trip?

7. Methodology:

User interviews will be conducted to collect qualitative and quantitative data from research participants. Interviews will be conducted in person and recorded to later transcribe with the interviewer's notes. A survey will be compiled from the interview questions and dispersed via Facebook and Instagram. Data collection will last for 4 to 5 days, to better form a user persona.

We suspect our participants will fall into two primary groups - those who are heavily involved in planning and those who are not. - What do you like and dislike about these tools?

Product opportunity questions:

- How likely would you be to use an app that helps coordinate group travel?
- Do you have any reservations about using this app or any new app?
- **Does this remind you of any other apps?**
- What features do you think could be useful? Do you have any suggestions/ideas...
