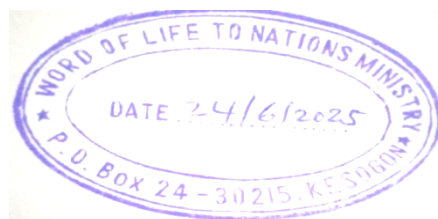

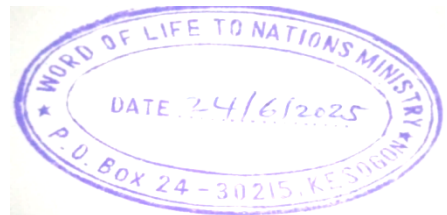

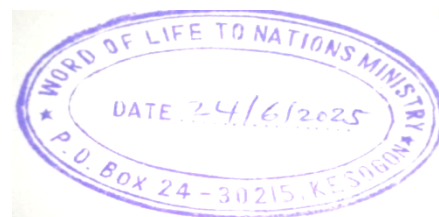

BACKGROUND/INTRODUCTION

Word of Life to Nations Ministry has been committed in improving livelihoods for over decades. Many children who are Orphans, Vulnerable and from needy from Kahuho Village were not going to school. Due to lack of education and Skill opportunities, Bishop Noah Muhando Simiyu of Word of Life to Nations Ministry was touched and started St. Elizabeth Mission School.

The School started with an ECDE class in the year 2017 and through support of the ministry and well-wishers it is up Grade 6 where pupils are supported by breakfast and lunch. The enrollment is 220 Kids in which the program will be able to give them a bright future.

This project leverages our past success in taking care of these children. The vocational training program will create sustainable solutions for those who will not continue with comprehensive learning from grade 6. It will give opportunity to those who are grown- ups and in need of vocational Skills.

PROBLEM STATEMENT

Poverty among Men and Women in Kahuho Area is significantly higher than the National average. Limited education, skill development opportunities and gender barriers contribute to this challenge, perpetuating cycles of poverty and dependency.

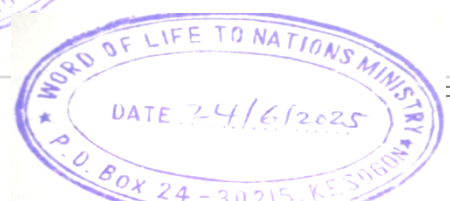
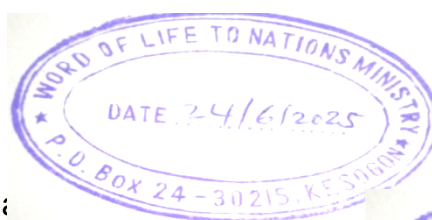

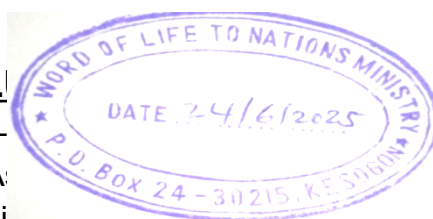
