ABSTRACT

The abstract should be typed in **Times New Roman, 11pt, 1 line spacing**. The abstract should include the following: The main problem being addressed; Objectives of the study; Methods used; Results; and Conclusions. The abstract must be written as a single paragraph, without references, abbreviations/acronyms, or footnotes. It should not be mathematical, a question, or conjecture. The abstract should not be a copy-paste of sentences from the manuscript. The abstract should be between **150-200 words** in length.

Keywords: keyword 1, keyword 2, keyword 3 (at least 3 keywords)

INTRODUCTION

The introduction should describe the fundamental issue or the urgency of the problem leading to research or study. It should be written in **Times New Roman, 12pt**.

LITERATURE REVIEW

The literature review should provide a discussion of relevant theories and previous studies related to the research topic.

Font: Times New Roman, 12pt. Ensure all theories cited in this section are listed in the **References** section.

METHOD

The methodology section should describe the techniques for data collection, data sources, data analysis methods, correlation tests, etc.

Font: Times New Roman, 12pt. This section may also include scientific formulas used for data analysis or correlation testing.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The results and discussion section should be written in **Times New Roman, 12pt**.

- The results should not include raw data but rather data that have been processed and analyzed according to the methods outlined.
- The discussion should compare the obtained results with the theories or concepts discussed in the literature review.

Subsection Example (Discussion 1):

- Discuss key topics in line with the research problem, objectives, and the theories applied.
- Citations should follow the format: (Author, Year: Page). For better accuracy, use Mendeley or Zotero for referencing.
- **Font:** Times New Roman, 12pt, 1.15 line spacing.

Figures and Tables: All tables and figures should be clearly numbered, titled, and referenced in the text. Tables should only use horizontal lines.

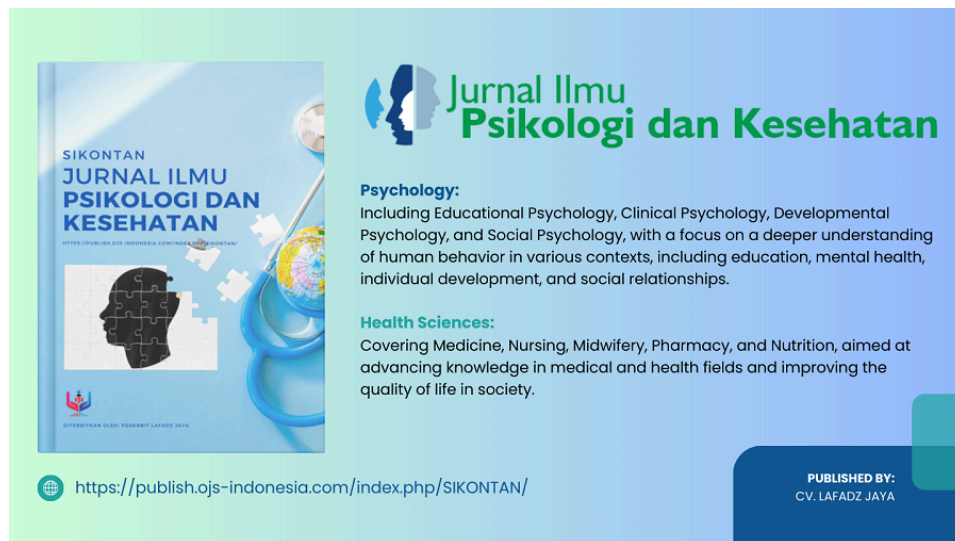


Figure 1. Learning Media Display

CONCLUSION

The conclusion should be written in **Times New Roman, 12pt**. The conclusion is a summary of the research conducted and should not simply restate the discussion but should be based on data analysis or correlation tests.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS (if any)

This section is optional and can be written depending on the author's preference. It should acknowledge those who supported the research or manuscript writing, particularly research funders.

REFERENCES

- A minimum of **10 sources** should be cited, with the majority published within the last **10 years**.

- References should follow the **APA 6th edition** style and it is recommended to use Mendeley or Zotero for managing citations.
- **Font:** Times New Roman, 12pt, 1.15 spacing, left-aligned.
