

Here is a list of hotels with easy access to our home. There are many, many other options if you want to do your own research, but these locations will require the least amount of walking and/or are conveniently located near a SunLink (trolley) station for you to quickly get to our house.

### **Best Western Royal Sun Inn and Suites**

-1015 N. Stone Ave

-free wifi, free parking, breakfast is paid

-This hotel is walking distance to our house, but a little farther from fun downtown Tucson food and activities (approx. 1 mile to downtown). Please be aware that there is a high likelihood that you will encounter houseless individuals when coming and going from the hotel, as there is a lot next to it and a park across the street that they frequent. They're generally very friendly folks, but wanted to bring it up for those of you that live rurally and may not be used to/as prepared for these types of encounters on a daily basis.

### **University Inn Tucson**

-950 N Stone Ave

-free wifi, breakfast, parking

-Modest rooms in a more motel-style affair. One of the cheaper options to be had. Basically in the same place as the BW Royal Sun, so see above for location description.

### **Tucson Marriott: University Park**

-880 E 2nd St

-free wifi, parking and breakfast are paid

-This spot is on the west edge of the UofA campus, spitting distance from where we both work. It's in great vicinity to museums and cultural activities, and there are many food options a short walk away (though not as good as what's in and around downtown). It will probably be quite "lively" at night with all of the college students. It's very close (~1/4mi or less) to the Tyndall Ave stop on the SunLink line, which you can use to easily get downtown, and would take two stops west followed by a 1/4 mile walk west to get to our house.

### **Hotel Congress**

-311 E Congress St

-free wifi

-Hotel Congress would be the "full" Tucson experience and fun if you are a heavy sleeper. It is a historic, urban, rock n' roll hotel located in the heart of downtown and includes several allegedly haunted rooms. Rooms are situated above a music venue, a bar, and a nightclub. Though no events are yet scheduled for Nov.10-11, it will definitely not be the most quiet experience—but surely a unique one! It is also home to the Cup Cafe, which has a particularly great brunch menu. Getting to our house from here would require you to walk 3/4 of a mile or to take the Sun Link east to the 4th St/4th Ave station and walk about 1/4 mile west from there.

### **Ramada by Wyndham Tucson**

-777 W Cushing St

-free wifi, parking, breakfast buffet

-This spot is a bit farther from our house, but right on the SunLink line and one of the cheaper options. You would take the Sun Link ~8 stops east to the 4th St/4th Ave station and walk ¼ mile west from there to our home. It is located one SunLink stop east from the MSA Annex, which is a hip, indoor/outdoor mall with lots of food and beverage options. It is located about 5 SunLink stops west of downtown, so you could easily access bars, music, restaurants, etc. in about 15 mins or less.

### **The Graduate Tucson**

-930 E 2nd St

-free wifi, paid parking/breakfast

The Graduate is a highly-rated 4-star hotel, so it will be on the pricier side. The rooftop pool/bar has a fantastic view, so even if you don't stay here, it might be worth checking out. Elevator access to non-guests is allowed to dine/drink, but pool access is restricted to guests.
