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Starting a CMIS Student Organization¹ Middle School & High School

Do you have an idea for a CMIS Student Organization? Then, consider these questions:

1. Is there no existing organization with a similar purpose?
2. Would the organization have a lasting relevance to the community?
3. Is there enough interest on campus to support the organization?

If You Answered "Yes", Consider Starting a CMIS Student Organization Today!

Step 1 - Founding and Meeting: Submit the [CMIS Student Organization Foundational Form](#) to the Director of Activities/Athletics for approval.

**If your club has no intention of fundraising then DO NOT complete step 2*

Step 2 - Fundraising: Submit the [CMIS Student Organization Charter Submission Form](#) along with a **Student Organization Charter** to the Director of Activities/Athletics.

Complete **Step 1**, and your CMIS Student Organization will be **founded** and approved to **meet**. Your organization may:

- (1) meet to conduct normal organization business, and
- (2) request access to CMIS facilities for events.

Complete **Step 2**, and your CMIS Student Organization will be approved to **fundraise**. Your organization may:

- (1) host pre-approved fundraising activities on campus,
 - (2) open a Student Organization Account with the Office of Student Life to deposit/withdraw student organization money, and
 - (3) apply for grants from Student Council.
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If at any time you have questions about the process for starting a CMIS Student Organization, meet with the Director of Activities/Athletics.
