Parent/Guardian(s): *I/we shall try to:*

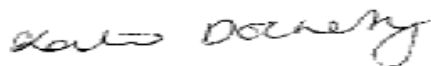
- See that my child goes to school regularly, on time and properly equipped and will telephone if absent.
