We are looking for an experienced freelance writer with excellent shorthand/notetaking skills to join the [News Futures 2035](#) initiative from the [Media Innovation Studio](#) at the University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) supported by the Google News Initiative.

The freelance writer's responsibilities include attendance at and detailed reporting on three plenary roundtables:

- Thursday 13 October and Friday 14 October 2022, London
- Thursday 24 November and Friday 25 November 2022, Manchester
- Thursday 2 February and Friday 3 February 2023, London

They will work with the project team to turn those notes into a range of outputs to support both research and public-engagement activities.

The freelancer will work approximately 10 full days over the course of the project. The rate of pay is £250 per day. We hope to select a freelance ASAP, but no later than 7 October 2022.
